Requesting a higher abstraction rate is considered a new application.

Application for a renewal should be submitted no later than three (3) months of expiration date or it will be treated as a new application

- Site visits may be required for an application and this may be at the applicant's expense
- Hydrometeorological Services may request additional information and or tests in order to complete the processing of an application. These additional activities may be at the applicant's expense.
- The outlined processes will be subject to fees, which are expected to be implemented in the future.
