Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00hrs Tuesday March 13, 2018, were available for most of the stations.
No significant rainfall was observed.

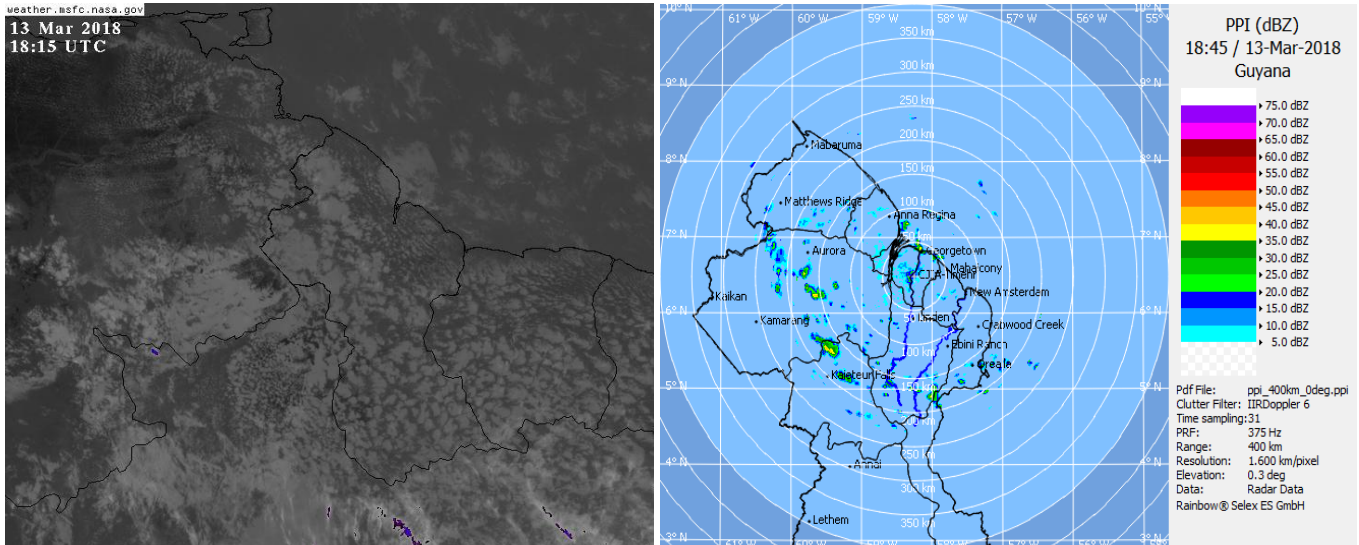
Synopsis: *High Pressure Ridge and Subsidence remains the controlling feature affecting Guyana.*

Today's weather review: *Mostly sunny skies were observed throughout Guyana with isolated showers.*
