WEATHER BRIEF for Thursday October 04, 2018 from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana



Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00hrs Thursday October 04, 2018, were available for most of the stations.

No significant rainfall was recorded.

Synopsis: Ridge of high pressure is the dominant feature affecting Guyana.

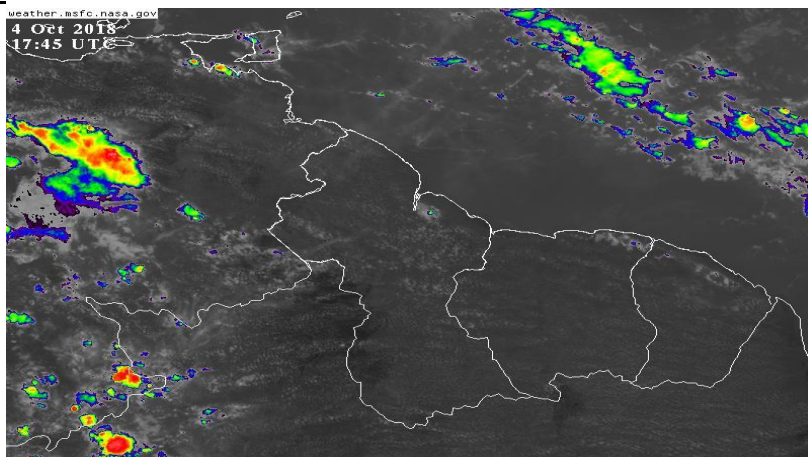
Today's weather review: Sunny skies were observed throughout Guyana with isolated showers.
