WEATHER BRIEF for Tuesday October 09, 2018 from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana



Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00hrs Tuesday October 09, 2018, were available for most of the stations.

The highest rainfall of 22.0mm was recorded at Wauna in Region 1.

Synopsis: Ridge of high pressure is the dominant feature.

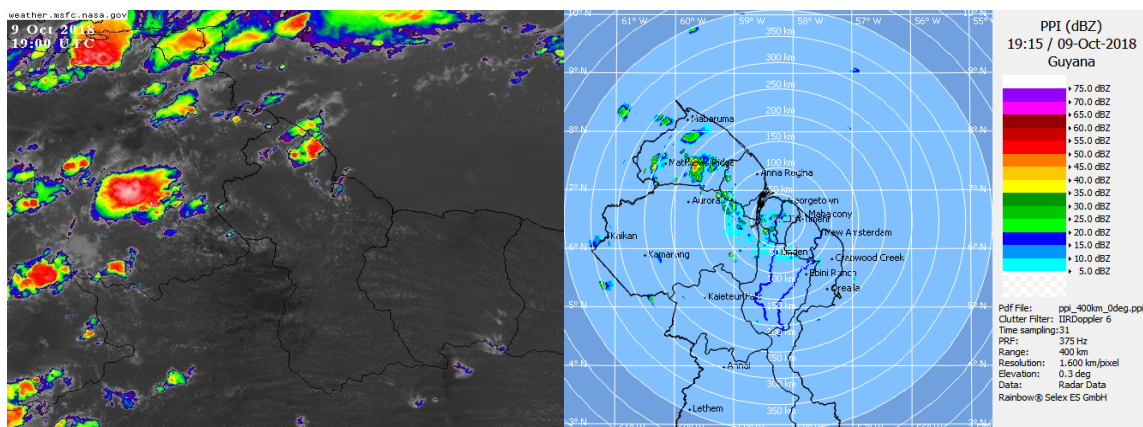
Today's weather review: Sunny skies with haze were observed throughout Guyana with isolated thundershowers in areas of Regions 1.
