WEATHER BRIEF for Thursday September 05, 2019 from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana



Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00hrs Thursday September 05, 2019, were available for most of the stations.

The highest rainfall of 50.0 mm was recorded at Kwatamang in Region 9.

Synopsis: High Pressure Ridging dominates across Guyana.

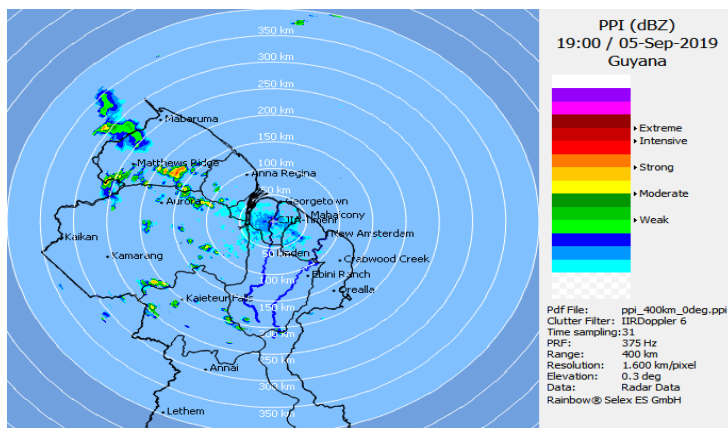
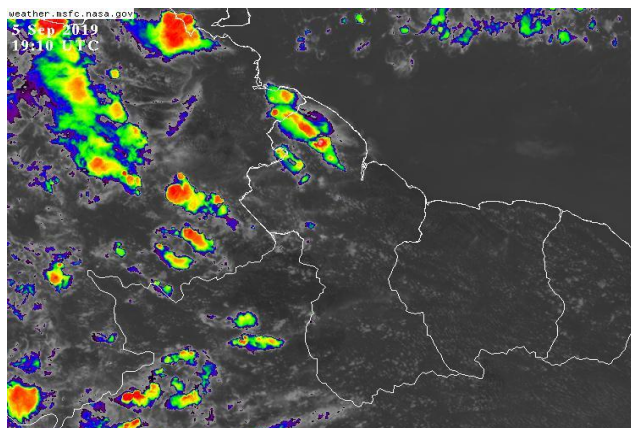
Today's weather review: Partly cloudy and sunny skies were observed throughout Guyana with isolated showers in areas of Regions 1, 2 and 7.
