### **WEATHER BRIEF for Friday September 06, 2019 from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana**



Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00hrs Friday September 06, 2019, were available for most of the stations.

**The highest rainfall of 23.3mm was recorded at Hossororo in Region 1.**

**Synopsis:** Localized instability due to day time heating along Guyana's Coastline was observed.

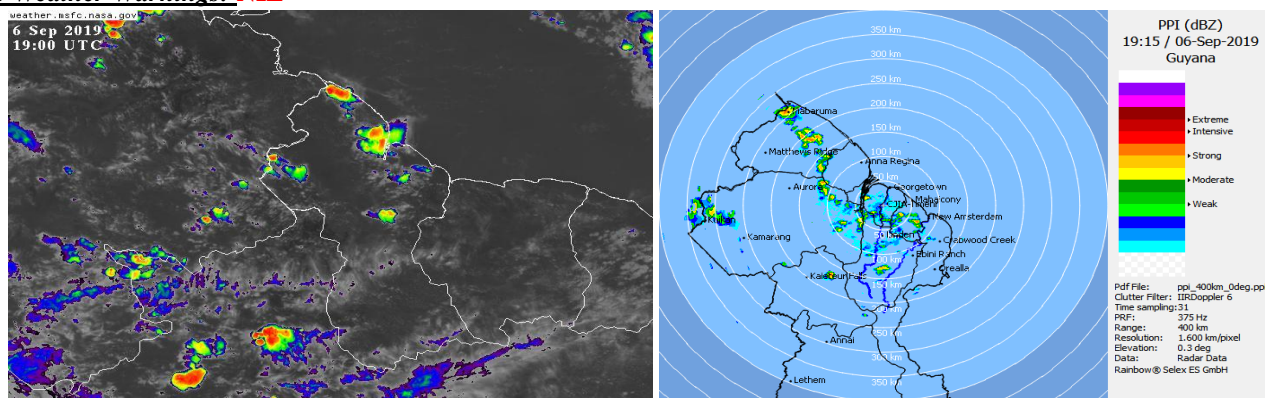
**Today's weather review:** Fair and sunny skies were observed throughout Guyana with isolated thundershowers over inland areas of Regions 1, 2, and 5.

### **Extended Forecast**

**Sunday thru Tuesday:** mostly fair and sunny skies throughout Guyana with few brief early morning showers in coastal areas and isolated thundershowers over near inland and inland areas during the afternoon. **Rainfall is anticipated between 0.0 mm to 15.0 mm within a 24 hours' period.**

**Wednesday and Thursday:** Generally cloudy skies with scattered to occasional showers and isolated thundershowers across Guyana. **Rainfall is anticipated between 10.0 mm to 30.0 mm within a 24 hours' period.**
