WEATHER BRIEF for Saturday, September 9, 2023, from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana



Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00 hrs Saturday, September 9, 2023, were available for most of the stations.

Wauna in Region 1 recorded the highest rainfall of 7.1 mm.

Synopsis: Dry and stable conditions continue throughout Guyana.

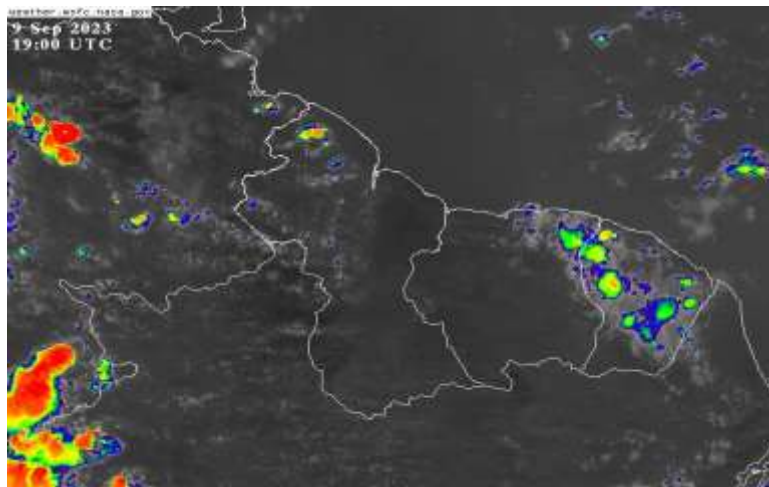
Today's weather review: Sunny skies were observed throughout Guyana.

Possibility of a few light passing showers. <u>Winds:</u> Gentle breeze varying from east to southeast. <u>Minimum temperatures:</u> Coast: 23 °C – 25 °C Hinterland: 22 °C – 24 °C	Regions 1 to 10	 No significant rainfall	Morning cloudy skies with a few light showers over regions 7 and 8. All other areas will see mostly sunny skies throughout the day. <u>Winds:</u> Moderate breeze varying from northeast to east. <u>Maximum temperatures:</u> Coast: 31 °C – 34 °C Hinterland: 32 °C – 35 °C

The long-term daily average rainfall for Georgetown, for the next 10 days September 9 to September 18, 2023, is 3.1mm per day.

- These waves are likely to have periods of between 6 and 10 seconds.
- Fresh easterly breeze.

Extended Forecast

Monday and Tuesday: Regions 7 to 10 will see mostly cloudy skies with scattered to occasional showers during the early morning hours. All other regions will see sunny skies with brief cloudy periods. **Rainfall is expected between 5 and 15 mm over regions 7 to 10, elsewhere, no significant rainfall is likely.**

Wednesday to Friday, sunny skies. **No significant rainfall.**
