WEATHER BRIEF for Wednesday 05 August 2026, from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana
Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00 hours on Wednesday, 05 August 2026, were available for some stations. 47 Miles Mabura Road in Region 10 recorded the highest rainfall of 33.7mm
Synopsis: Saharan Air Layer (SAL), ridging, and local convection are the dominant features over Guyana. The atmosphere is mostly stable..

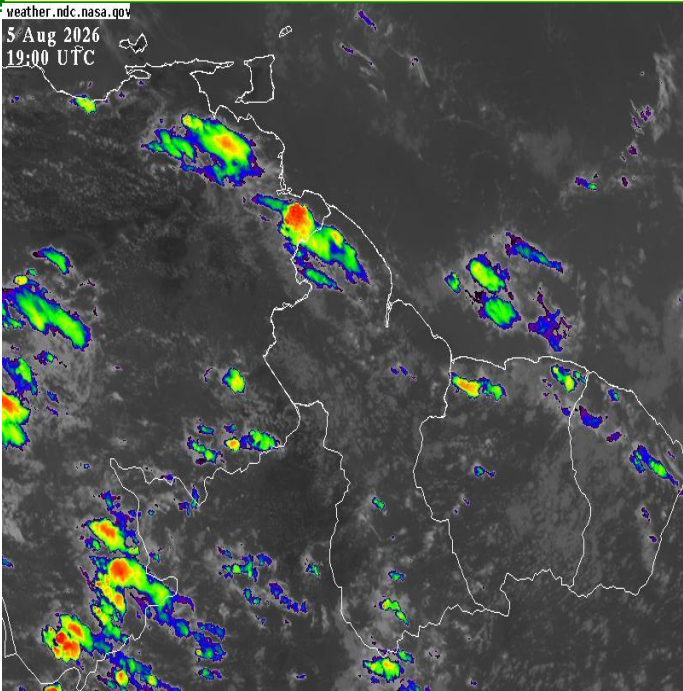
Weather review: Except for scattered showers over hilly and sandy districts, mostly sunny skies dominated.

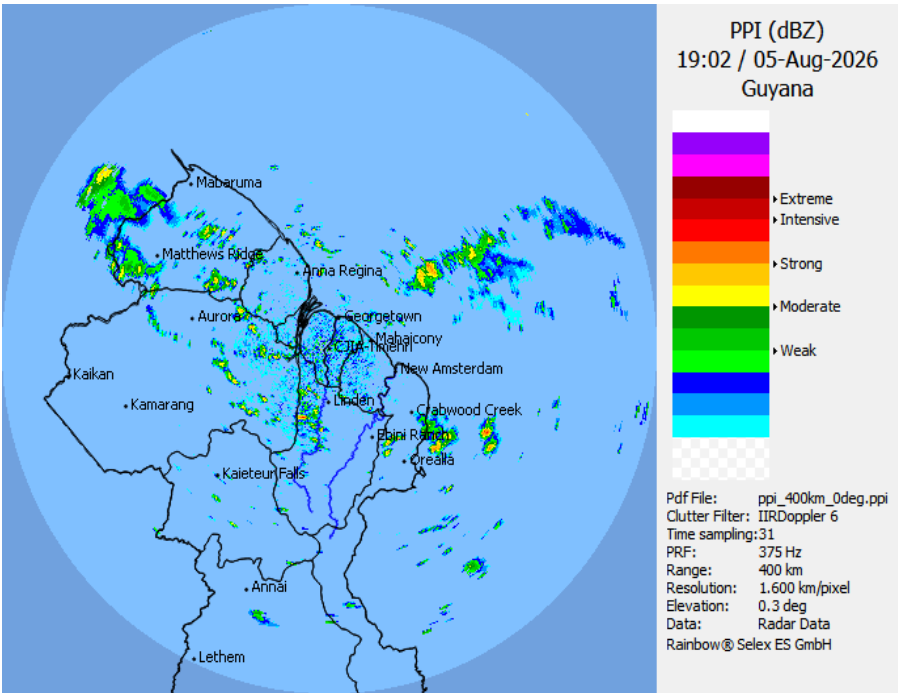

SEA CONDITIONS: Moderate in open waters with North-easterly swells reaching 1.0 to 2.0 meters (3 to 6ft) and increasing.

These waves will likely have periods of 7 and 8 seconds,

Winds: Light to Gentle Easterly to South-easterly breeze.

Friday: Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with scattered showers over Regions 1 to 4. In the other Regions, mostly fair and sunny skies. **Rainfall is expected to range between 0 and 10mm.**

Saturday: Except for scattered showers in the morning over Regions 1 to 4, mostly fair and sunny skies. **Rainfall is expected to range between 0 and 10mm.**

Sunday through Tuesday: Mostly fair and sunny skies are expected to be interrupted by periods of cloudiness with brief passing showers over coastal areas in the morning. Elsewhere, no significant rainfall. **Rainfall is expected to range between 0 and 10mm.**
