WEATHER BRIEF for Thursday 13 August 2026, from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana

Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00 hours on Thursday, 13 August 2026, were available for some stations. Springland Forestry in Region 6 recorded the highest rainfall of 17.4mm

Synopsis: Remnants of a Tropical wave (Tw) and local convection generated weak to moderate instability over Regions 7, 10 and inland areas of Regions 1 and 2. Elsewhere, the atmosphere was mostly stable. For the next 18 to 24 hours. An area of disturbed weather coupled with the Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) is expected to generate moderate instability; most of the instability is expected over Northern Guyana. Elsewhere, mostly stable atmosphere.

Weather review: Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with scattered showers and isolated thundershowers over inland areas. In the other areas, mostly sunny skies..

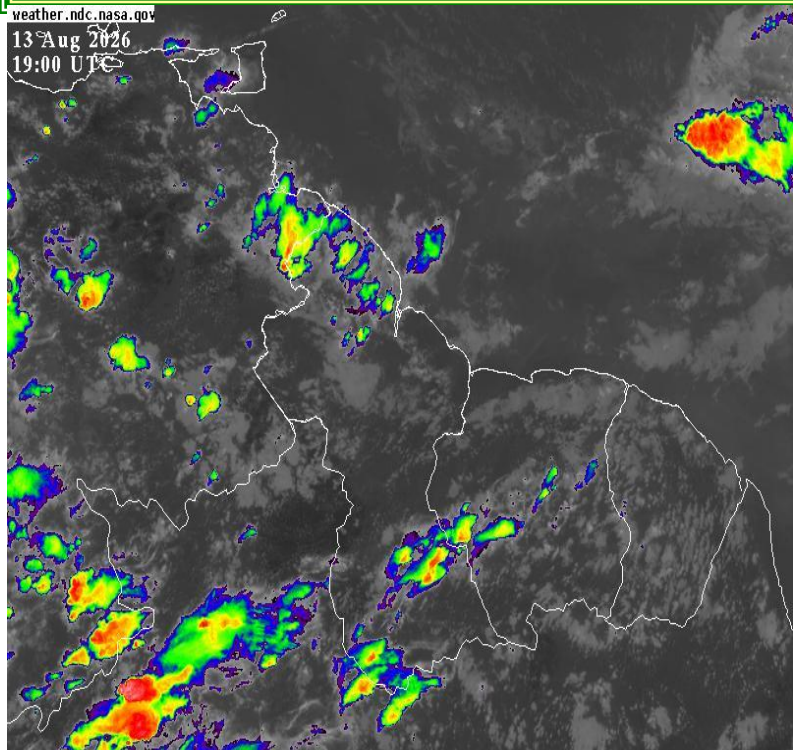

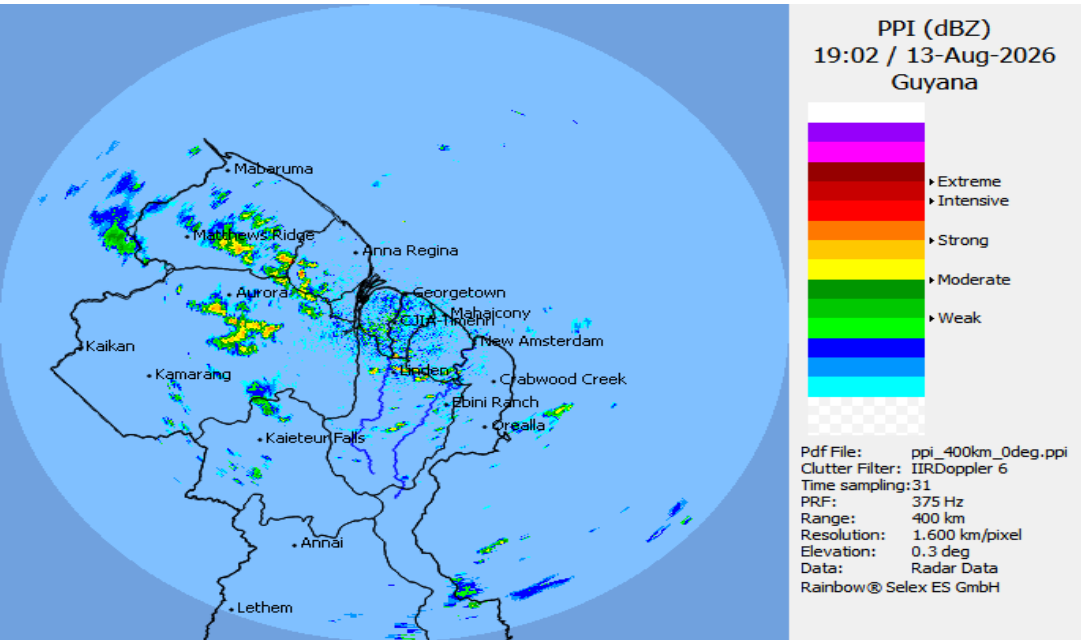
Georgetown's long-term daily average rainfall for the next 10 days, 13 August to 22 August 2026, is 9.7mm per day.

Winds: Light to Gentle Easterly to South-easterly breeze.

Saturday: Early morning showers over coastal areas. In the late morning and the remainder of the forecast period, Regions 1, 2, 7, and 8 can expect scattered to occasional showers. In the other Regions, except for brief passing showers, mostly sunny skies. **Rainfall is expected to range between 0 and 20mm.**

Sunday: In the early morning, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with scattered to occasional showers over Region 8, and coastal areas of Regions 1 to 3. Elsewhere, no significant rainfall. For the remainder of the forecast period, except for some showers over Regions 1 and 2, mostly sunny skies. **Rainfall is expected to range between 0 and 15mm.**

Monday through Wednesday: Mostly fair and sunny skies may be interrupted by periods of cloudiness with scattered showers in all Regions. **Rainfall is expected to range between 0 and 15mm.**
