WEATHER BRIEF for Tuesday 10, December 2024, from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana-

Synopsis: Low-level convergence generated weak to moderate instability over the forecast areas. the current feature will continue for the next 12 to 18 hours.

Today's Weather review: Cloudy to overcast skies with scattered to occasional showers and rain over all Regions.

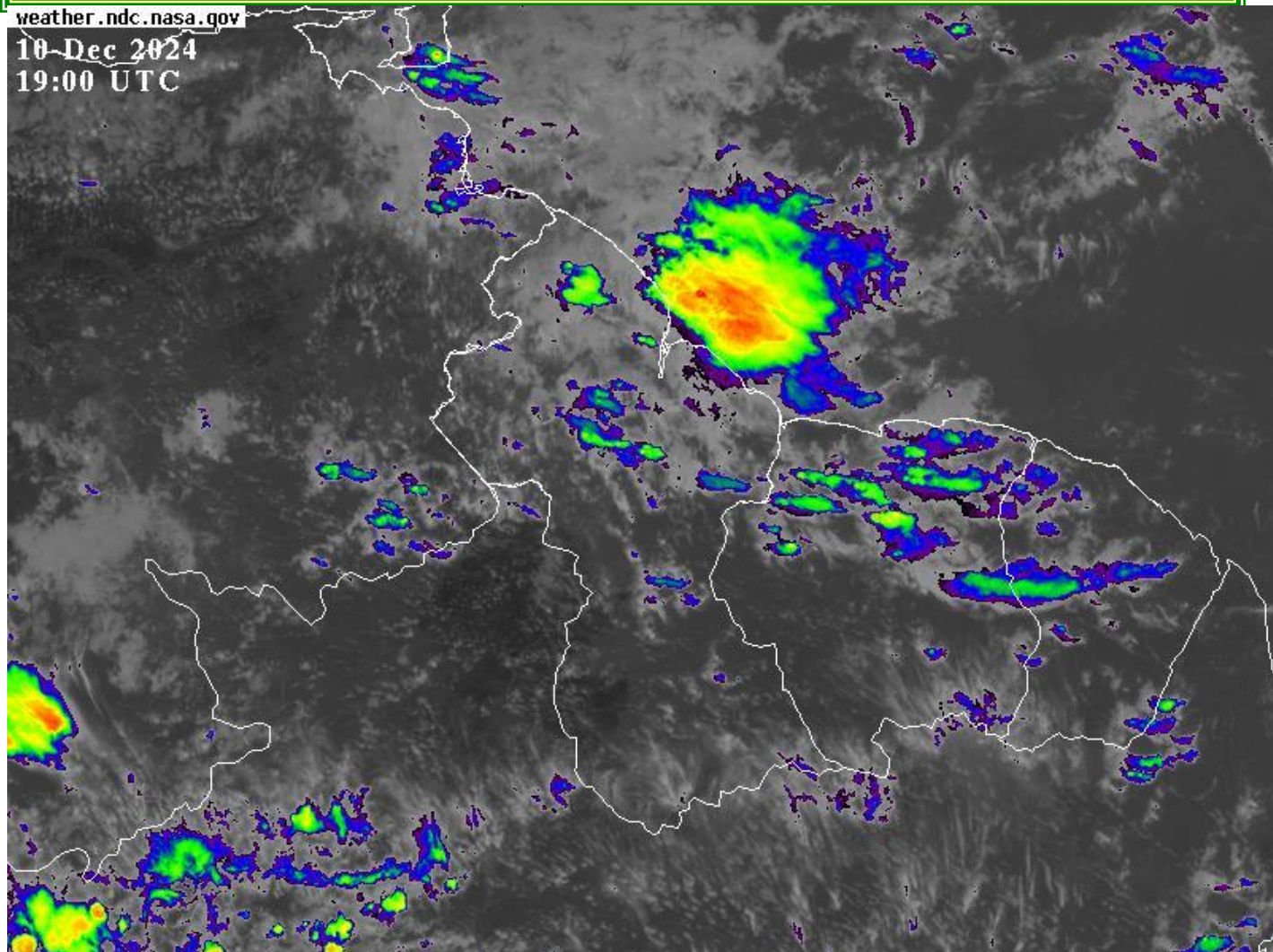
Georgetown's long-term daily average rainfall for the next 10 days, December 10 to December 19, is 9.5 mm per day.

SPRING TIDE ADVISORY: Is In Effect.

SEA CONDITIONS: Moderate seas from the Northeast with swells reaching 2.0 to 2.5 meters in open waters. These waves will likely have periods of between 08 and 09 seconds.

Winds: -Light to Gentle Northeasterly to Easterly.

Thursday: Mostly fair and sunny skies are expected to be interrupted by scattered showers over all Regions. **Rainfall is between 0.0 and 10.0 mm the maximum over Region 5, North, and Central Region 6.**

Friday and Saturday: Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with no significant rainfall in the morning, for the remainder of the day, all Regions can expect scattered showers. **Rainfall is expected to be 0.0 and 15.0 mm, the maximum over North and Central Region 6.**

Sunday and Monday: Except for brief showers, mostly fair and sunny skies are expected to dominate. **Rainfall is not expected to be significant.**
