**Weather Brief for Thursday, 11 December 2025 from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana.**

Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00hrs Thursday, 11 December 2025 were available for most of the stations. **Kumaka in Region 1 recorded the highest rainfall of 76.5 mm.**

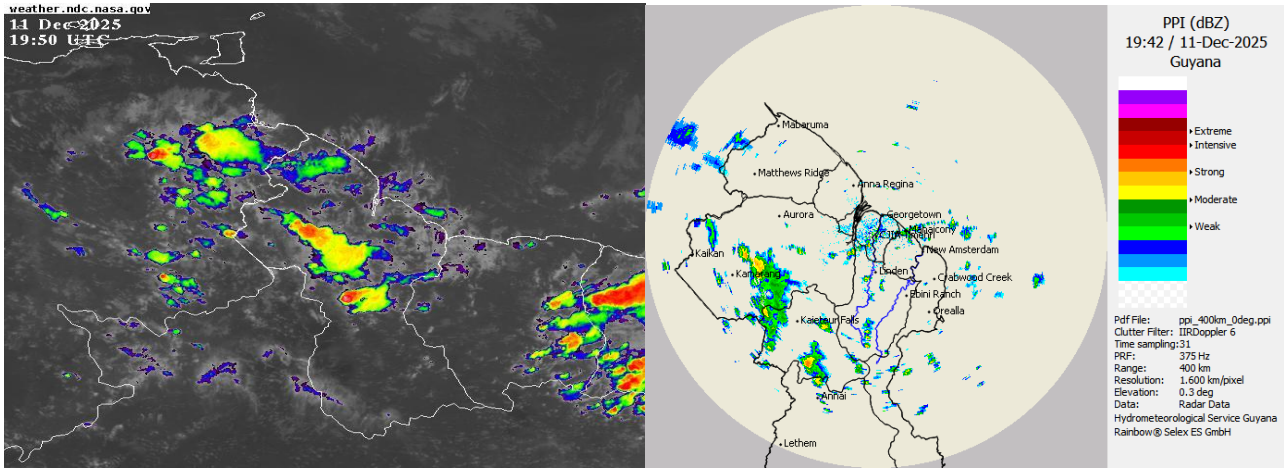
**Synopsis:** Moisture plumes within the trades are oscillating across Guyana, producing moderate instabilities. With the high-pressure ridge building and pushing further south, this created a tightened pressure gradient, producing fresh Tradewinds across the region. This pattern is expected to continue into the weekend.

**Today's weather review:** Cloudy skies were observed across Guyana with scattered showers and isolated thundershowers.

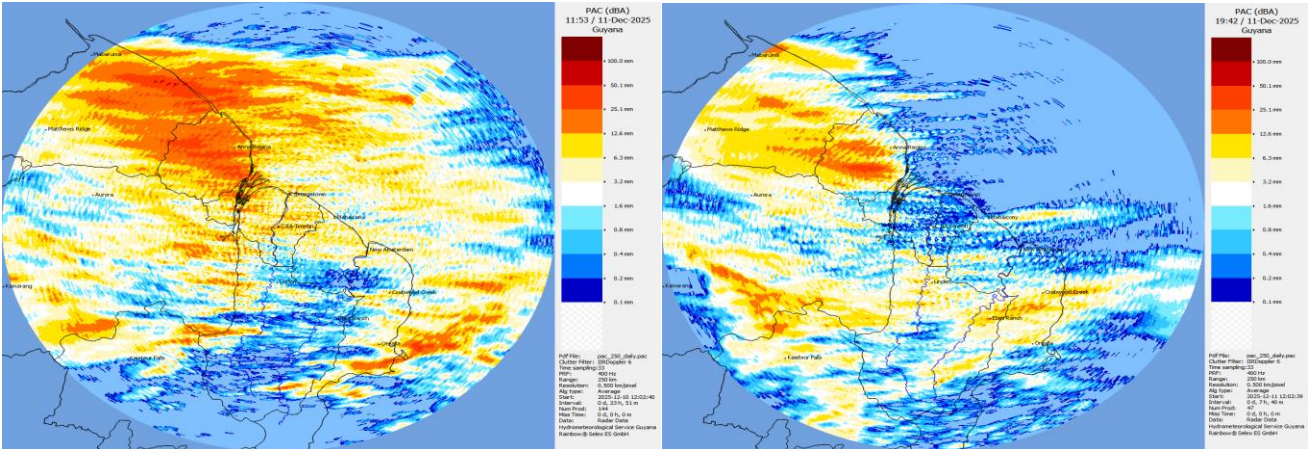

## Sea conditions

Rough in open waters with northeast to easterly swells reaching 2.5 to 3.5 meters (7 to 10 ft) and increasing.

- These waves will likely have periods of 8 and 9 seconds
- Fresh northeast to easterly breeze.

## Extended Forecast

**Saturday:** Occasionally cloudy skies with brief showers over coastal areas in the morning. All other areas will see intermittent to frequent showers in the afternoon. **Rainfall is expected to be between 10 and 30 mm.**

**Sunday:** cloudy skies with frequent showers and isolated thundershowers over regions 6 to 10. All other areas will see brief to scattered light showers. Rainfall is anticipated to be between 30 and 60 mm over regions 6 to 10 and between 0 and 10 mm elsewhere.

**Monday and Tuesday**, late morning into afternoon, cloudy to overcast skies with intermittent showers and thundershowers over regions 7, 10, and inland regions 3 to 5. **Rainfall is expected to be between 20 and 50 mm over these areas.** All other regions will see fair and sunny skies. **Rainfall is expected to be less than 10 mm.**

**Wednesday:** Mostly fair and sunny skies can be expected. Rainfall is anticipated to be less than 10 mm.
