Weather Brief for Wednesday, 17 December 2025 from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana.

Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00hrs Wednesday, 17 December 2025 were available for most of the stations. De Kinderen Back in Region 3 recorded the highest rainfall of 13.5mm.


<u>Synopsis:</u> Weak instabilities within moisture plumes from the high-pressure ridge are affecting Guyana. The presence of Saharan Dust has significantly increased stability and dry air. This pattern is expected to remain for the remainder of the week.

Today's weather review: A mix of sunshine and clouds with brief to scattered showers was observed across Guyana.

Extended Forecast

Friday: A mix of sunshine and clouds with brief to scattered showers across Guyana. Rainfall is expected to be between 0 and 15 mm.

<u>Saturday</u>, Cloudy skies across Guyana with occasional afternoon showers and isolated thundershowers. Rainfall between 0 and 20 mm.

<u>Sunday to Tuesday</u>, cloudy to overcast skies with intermittent to frequent showers and isolated thundershowers. Rainfall is anticipated to be between 20 and 50 mm within 24 hours of accumulation.
