Weather Brief for Thursday, 19 December 2024 from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana.

Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00 hrs Thursday, 19 December 2024 were available for most of the stations. Coomacka in Region 10 recorded the highest rainfall of 62.4mm.


Synopsis: Weak to moderate instabilities continue to affect Guyana. This pattern is expected to continue over the weekend.
