Marine Advisory: - High energy and spring tides will likely result in overtopping of river and sea defences and can also cause damage to sea defences in vulnerable areas. Persons residing in low-lying, riverine, and flood-prone areas are advised to take the necessary precautions to safeguard life and property.

- Strong surface winds will also result in rough and dangerous seas. Fisherfolk, small craft operators, and other marine users are advised to remain alert and exercise caution during this time.

Severe Weather Advisory: In areas of thundershowers, heavy winds and possible lightning strikes can be expected. Persons are encouraged to exercise caution in efforts to safeguard life and property.



Weather Brief for Sunday, 07 December 2025 from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana.

Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00hrs Sunday, 07 December 2025 were available for most of the stations. Sharima in Region 7 recorded the highest rainfall of 11.0mm.

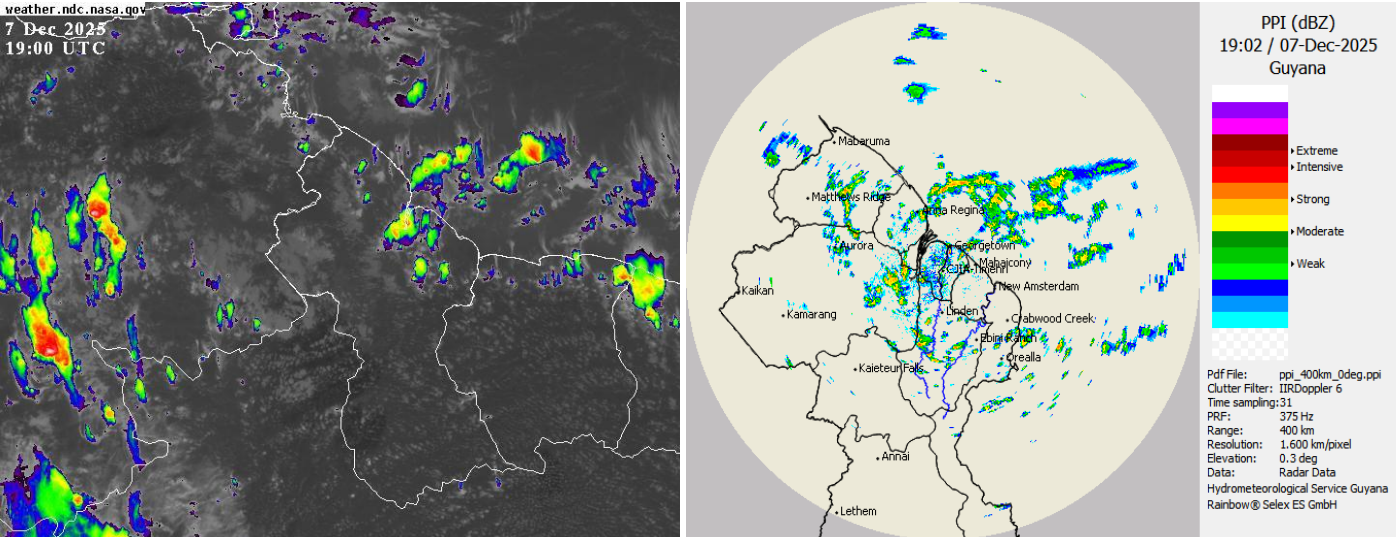
Synopsis: Shallow to moderate moisture plumes embedded within the trades are affecting northern Guyana. Over the coming days, the ITCZ is expected to become organised and oriented along coastal Guyana.

Today's weather review: Mostly cloudy skies with scattered showers and isolated thundershowers over coastal and near inland areas. All other areas experienced fair and sunny skies with a few cloudy periods.

SPRING TIDE ADVISORY: Persons are reminded that the Spring Tide Advisory will remain in effect until Tuesday, December 9, 2025. Spring tides coupled with high waves may lead to overtopping of the river and sea defence vulnerable areas. All necessary precautions should be taken.

Sea conditions:

Moderate to rough in open waters with northeast to easterly swells reaching 2.0 to 3.0 meters (6 to 8 ft) and increasing.

- These waves will likely have periods of 8 and 9 seconds
- Moderate to Fresh northeast to easterly breeze.

Extended Forecast

Tuesday to Friday: Cloudy to overcast skies with intermittent to frequent showers can be expected across northern Guyana. Southern Guyana will see fair to occasionally cloudy skies with isolated to scattered showers. **Rainfall is anticipated to be between 30 and 60 mm within 24 hours of accumulation.**
