**WEATHER BRIEF for Sunday 08 February 2026, from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana-**

*Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00 hours on Sunday, 08 February 2026, were available for some stations. **Lesbeholden in Region 06 recorded the highest rainfall of 6.3mm.***

**Synopsis:** Weak to moderate instability dominated the forecast area. The Saharan Air Layer (SAL) is the dominant feature, which played a major role in suppressing deep convection.

**Weather review:** Mostly sunny skies were interrupted by brief showers, mostly in inland areas.




***Georgetown's long-term daily average rainfall for the next 10 days, 08 to 17 February 2026, is 4.2m per day.***

**Friday and Saturday: Mostly fair and sunny skies are expected to be interrupted by periods of cloudiness with brief showers in all Regions. **Rainfall between 0 and 10mm****
