**Marine Advisory: High surface winds coupled with high-energy waves present a risk to river and sea defences in vulnerable locations. Residents in low-lying and riverine areas are urged to remain vigilant and prepared to respond to changing conditions.**

**Weather Brief for Thursday, 12 February 2026 from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana.**

Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00 hrs Thursday, 12 February 2026 were available for most of the stations.

**South Ruimveldt Front in Region 4 recorded the highest rainfall of 96.7 mm.**


**Synopsis:** A slow-moving low-level trough brought unstable conditions and showers to coastal areas this morning before moving inland and gradually weakening. More stable conditions are expected to return from tomorrow and continue into the new week across Guyana. Notwithstanding, the progression of another low-level trough is being monitored, which may affect Southern Guyana from late Saturday into early Sunday morning and could result in increased cloudiness and showers.

**Today's weather review:** Cloudy to overcast skies with moderate to heavy thundershowers and rain over regions 2 to 5, 7, and 10. All other areas saw cloudy skies.

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Sea conditions:

**Open waters are expected to be moderate to rough with northeasterly swells reaching 2.0 to 3.0 metres (6 to 8 feet) and steady.**

- Wave periods are forecast to range between 7 and 11 seconds.
- Moderate to Fresh northeast to easterly breeze expected.

**Extended Forecast**

**Saturday:** fair to occasionally cloudy skies with scattered to occasional afternoon showers. Rainfall is anticipated to be between 0 and 20 mm.

**Sunday** Early morning cloudy to overcast skies with frequent showers and rain. Rainfall is anticipated to be between 30 and 60 mm over southern Guyana and elsewhere, less than 25 mm.

**Monday and Tuesday,** partly cloudy to cloudy skies can be expected across Guyana with brief to scattered showers. Rainfall is anticipated to be between 0 and 15 mm.

**Wednesday:** Frequent showers and rain over southern Guyana. All other areas will see fair and sunny skies with brief passing showers in the morning. Rainfall is expected to be between 30 and 60 mm over Southern Guyana. Elsewhere, less than 15 mm.
