**Marine Advisory:** The ongoing Spring Tides, together with high-energy waves and long-period waves, pose a risk of overtopping and damage to river and sea defences in vulnerable locations. Persons in low-lying and riverine areas should remain alert and take steps to safeguard life and property.

**Weather Brief for Thursday, 05 February 2026 from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana.**

Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00 hrs Thursday, 05 February 2026 were available at most stations. **Cane Grove Back in Region 4, recorded the highest rainfall of 12.4 mm.**


**Synopsis:** Weak to moderate moisture plumes embedded within the low-level Tradewind flow are influencing Guyana and are expected to persist through the remainder of the week. Late Sunday into Monday, the passage of a surface trough across northern Guyana will enhance low-level convergence and instability, resulting in moderately unstable conditions.

**Today's weather review:** Mostly cloudy skies were observed across Guyana with brief to scattered showers over regions 3 to 5, and 7.

**SPRING TIDE ADVISORY:** The public is advised that the Spring Tide Advisory will remain in effect through Friday, February 6, 2026.

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Sea conditions:

**Open waters are expected to be moderate to rough, with northeast to easterly swells reaching 2.0 to 3.0 metres (6 to 8 feet) and decreasing.**

- Wave periods are forecast to range between 8 and 10 seconds.
- Moderate northeast to easterly breeze expected.

Extended Forecast

Saturday: Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with a few brief showers. Rainfall is expected to be between 0 and 10 mm.

Sunday: Fair and sunny skies through mid-afternoon. Thereafter, skies are expected to become mostly cloudy to overcast in some parts towards the evening with scattered to occasional showers. Rainfall is anticipated to be between 10 and 20 mm.

Monday: Cloudy to overcast skies with frequent showers and intermittent rain. Rainfall is anticipated to be between 10 and 40 mm.

Tuesday and Wednesday, mostly cloudy skies with intermittent showers. Rainfall is anticipated to be between 10 and 25 mm within 24 hours of accumulation.
