**WEATHER BRIEF for today Sunday, 12 July 2026, from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana**

*Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00 hrs Sunday, July 12, 2026, were available for most stations.*

***Johanna South in Region 6 recorded the highest rainfall of 75.8 mm.***

**Marine Advisory:** Citizens are advised that the spring tide advisory is in effect. Residents of low-lying, riverine, and flood-prone areas are advised to take the necessary precautions against flooding, as over-topping is likely.

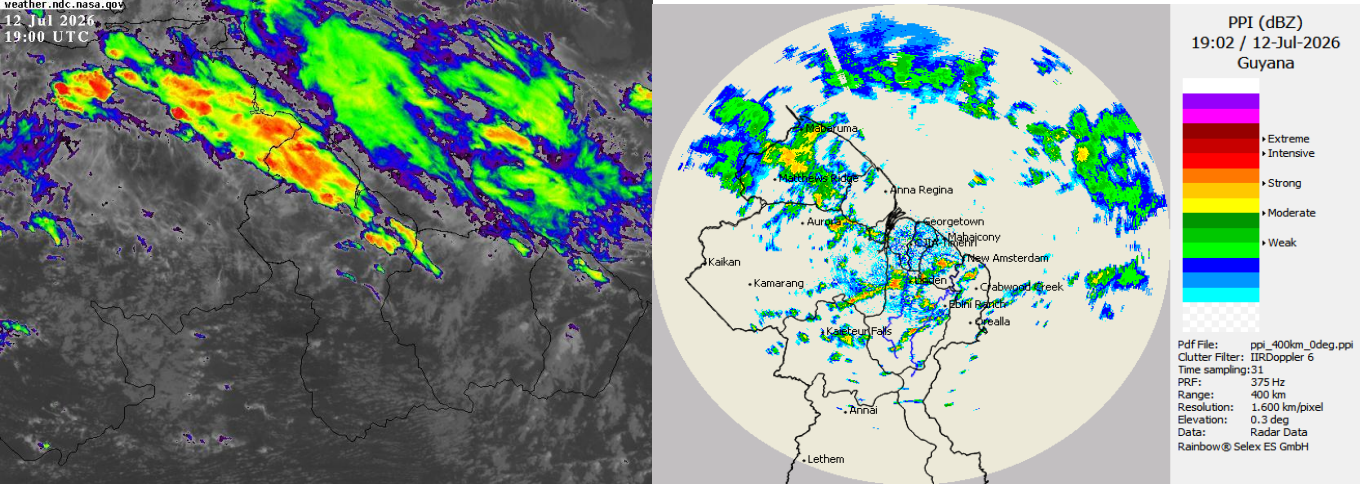
**Severe Weather Warnings.** Rainfall amounts forecasted can increase the likelihood of or exacerbate flooding in low-lying areas and areas of poor drainage within the next 12 hours. In areas of thundershowers, heavy winds and lightning strikes may be observed. Persons are asked to be alert and exercise caution in efforts to safeguard life and property.

**Synopsis:** *The ITCZ was analyzed over Regions 1 and 2 and will likely affect those Regions throughout the night. Region 7 is also expected to be affected by this system. Regions 3 to 6 also experience mild to moderate convection from mid-morning and into the afternoon. A low-level trough seen at the 850 mb, coupled with moisture convergence, was the primary cause of these instabilities. Localized diurnal heating also contributed to these conditions, especially over Inland areas of these Regions. Based on meteorological models, Coastal Guyana is expected to experience moderate instabilities during the early morning.*

**Today's weather review:** *Cloudy skies with isolated to scattered showers and thundershowers were observed over Inland areas along Regions 1 to 7.*

**SPRING TIDE ADVISORY: CITIZENS ARE ADVISED THAT THE SPRING TIDE ADVISORY IS IN EFFECT AND WILL CONTINUE UNTIL SUNDAY, JULY 19, 2026. RESIDENTS OF LOW-LYING, RIVERINE, AND FLOOD-PRONE AREAS ARE ADVISED TO TAKE THE NECESSARY PRECAUTIONS AGAINST FLOODING AS OVERTOPPING IS LIKELY.**

**SEA CONDITIONS: MODERATE SEAS WITH NORTH-EASTERLY WAVES REACHING HEIGHTS OF 1.5 TO 2.5 METERS IN OPEN WATERS. THESE WAVES ARE LIKELY TO HAVE PERIODS OF 7 AND 8 SECONDS. GENTLE TO MODERATE EASTERLY BREEZE.**

### *Extended Forecast*

**Friday:** Cloudy skies with scattered showers, rain, and isolated thundershowers can be expected over 1 to 7 and 10. Coastal Regions can expect these conditions during the morning period with improvements expected during the late afternoon. All remaining regions can expect partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated showers during the afternoon. **Rainfall is expected to range between 20.0 mm and 60.0 mm over Regions 1 to 7 and 10, with the highest expected over Regions 1, 2, and 7. Elsewhere, rainfall is not expected to be significant.**

***Saturday through Tuesday:*** Cloudy skies with light to moderate showers can be expected over Coastal Regions during the early morning hours. Improvements are expected from mid-morning as partly cloudy and sunny skies will likely persist. All remaining areas can expect cloudy skies with isolated to scattered showers and thundershowers from the afternoon. ***Rainfall is expected to range from 5.0 mm to 35.0 mm within 24 hours, with the highest amounts in areas with thundershowers.***
