### WEATHER BRIEF for today Friday, 06 March 2026, from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana

Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00 hrs Friday, March 6, 2026, were available for most stations.

**Good Success Wakenaam in Region 2 recorded the highest rainfall of 22.6 mm.**

**Dust Advisory:** Mild concentrations of the Saharan Dust are still present over Guyana's Coastal Regions, resulting in hazy skies, reduced visibility, and moderate to poor air quality. People sensitive to air quality changes are advised to take all necessary precautions.


**Marine advisory:** Spring tide, coupled with moderate to rough seas, will likely result in overtopping of sea defenses and hazardous sea conditions. All marine users and persons in low-lying and riverine areas are asked to take the necessary precautions.

**Synopsis:** The atmosphere over the forecast area is unstable due to moisture convergence embedded within low-level troughs. However, mild concentrations of the Saharan Dust are diminishing the effects of the convection associated with these troughs. This pattern is expected to continue for the next 12 to 24 hours. Moisture plume is expected to increase into the new week, which will enhance total precipitation over Guyana.

**Today's weather review:** Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated to scattered showers can be expected over Inland areas.

**SEA CONDITIONS: MODERATE TO ROUGH SEAS WITH NORTHEASTERLY TO EASTERLY SWELLS REACHING HEIGHTS OF 2.5 TO 3.5 METERS IN OPEN WATERS. THESE WAVES ARE LIKELY TO HAVE PERIODS OF 9 AND 10 SECONDS. MODERATE TO FRESH NORTHEASTERLY TO EASTERLY BREEZE.**

**Extended Forecast**

**Sunday and Monday:** Cloudy skies with isolated to scattered showers can be expected over Coastal Guyana during the morning, with conditions expected to improve from the afternoon hours as partly cloudy to fair skies will likely persist. Cloudy skies with isolated showers, ranging from light to moderate, can be expected over Inland and Southern Guyana from the afternoon. **Rainfall is not expected to exceed 30.0 mm within 24 hours.**

**Tuesday through Thursday:** Cloudy skies with scattered showers ranging from light to moderate can be expected over Coastal Guyana during the morning, with conditions expected to improve from the afternoon. Inland and Southern Guyana can expect cloudy skies, becoming overcast at times, with scattered to frequent showers, and intermittent rain can be expected during the afternoon. **Rainfall is not expected to exceed 50.0 mm within 24 hours.**
