**WEATHER BRIEF for today Tuesday, 18 March 2025, from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana**

Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00 hrs Tuesday, March 18, 2025, were available for most stations.





**Aishalton in Region 09 recorded the highest rainfall of 23.9 mm**

**Severe Weather Advisory: None at this time**

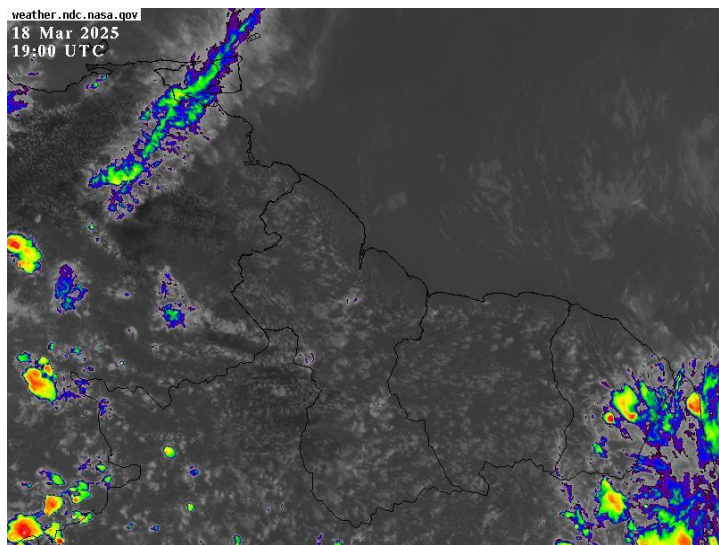
**Marine Advisory: High energy waves can lead to damages to vulnerable sea defences and choppy sea conditions.**

**Synopsis:** Generally stable conditions were observed over most of the forecast area. Ridging at the surface coupled with drying out of the atmosphere from the low to upper levels are the primary reasons for these conditions. Generally stable conditions are expected to continue over the forecast area. However, isolated pockets of instabilities can result in mild instabilities during the forecast period.

**Today's weather review:** Partly cloudy to fair and sunny skies were observed over most of the forecast area.

**Extended Forecast**

**Thursday through Monday:** Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated to scattered showers can be expected over Coastal Guyana during the early morning with fair and sunny skies expected from the afternoon. Inland and Southern Guyana can expect cloudy spells with isolated to scattered showers from the afternoon. **Rainfall is expected to range between 0.0 mm and 15.0 mm within 24 hours.**
