WEATHER BRIEF for today Saturday, 25 October 2025, from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana

Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00 hrs Saturday, October 25, 2025, were available for most stations.

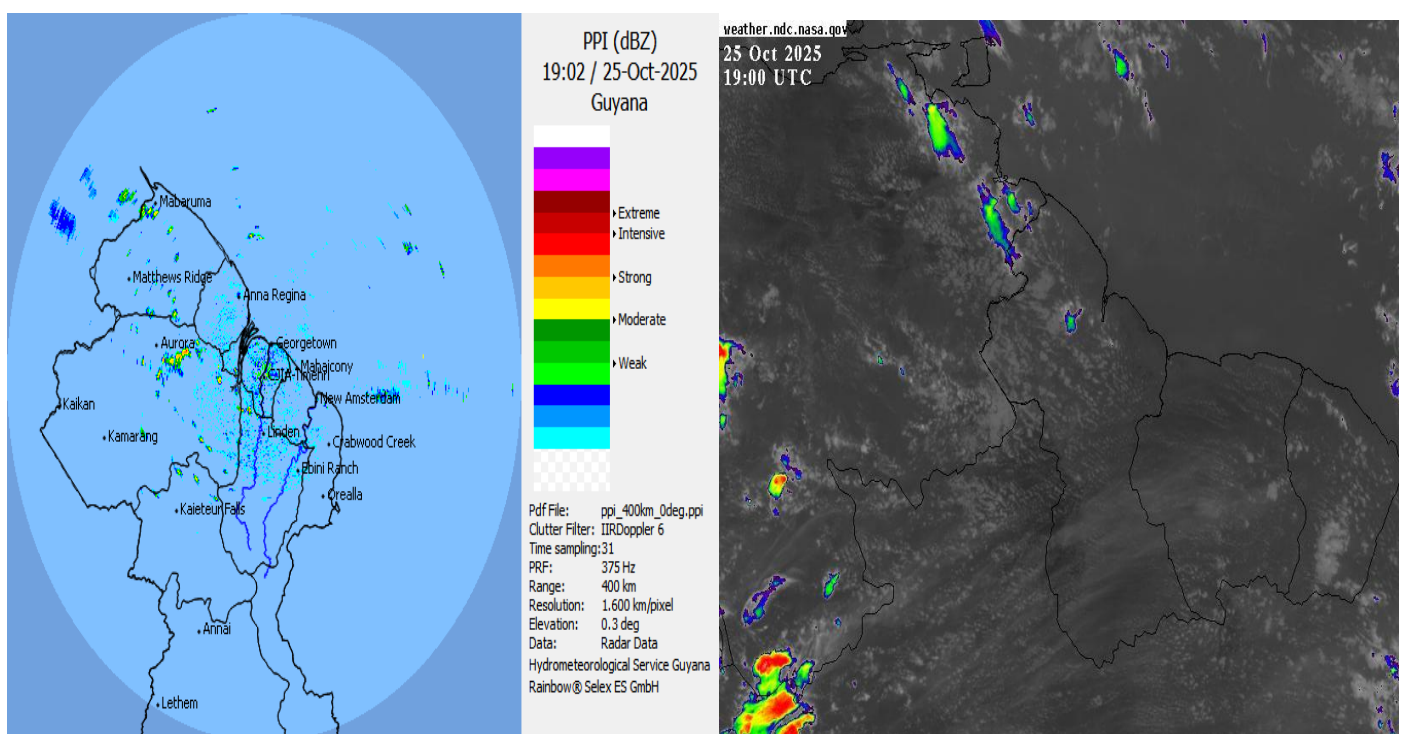
Matthews Ridges in Region 1 recorded the highest rainfall of 2.0 mm.

Synopsis: Mostly stable conditions continued over most of the forecast areas. Ridging throughout the atmosphere was the most significant feature of interest. This pattern is expected to continue for the next 12 hours and into the new week. However, localized diurnal heating produced mild instabilities over some Inland areas during the afternoon. Meteorological models are indicating that the forecast area is expected to become mildly unstable on Wednesday as a Tropical wave is likely to enter the area.

Today's weather review: *Partly cloudy to sunny skies were observed over Regions 2 to 10. Isolated showers were observed over Region 1.*

Extended Forecast

Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday: Partly cloudy skies with isolated showers can be expected over Coastal Regions 2 to 6 during the morning hours, with partly cloudy to sunny skies likely to persist from mid-morning. Region 1, Inland and Southern Guyana can expect cloudy to overcast skies with isolated showers, thundershowers from the afternoon. **Rainfall is expected to be between 0.0 and 15.0 mm within 24 hours.**

Wednesday: *Cloudy skies with isolated to scattered showers of varying intensities can be expected over Coastal Guyana during the morning hours, with conditions expected to improve from the afternoon. Inland and Hinterland can expect cloudy to overcast skies with isolated showers and thundershowers from the afternoon. Rainfall is anticipated to be between 5.0 and 25.0 mm.*
