Weather Brief for Friday, 09 January 2026 from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana.

Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00 hrs Friday, 09 January 2026 were available for most of the stations.

Mahdia in Region 8 recorded the highest rainfall of 35.2 mm.


Synopsis: Weak to moderate instabilities within moisture plumes are affecting Guyana. This pattern is expected to continue over the weekend.

Today's weather review: Mostly cloudy skies with scattered to intermittent showers across Guyana.

Sea conditions:

Moderate in open waters with northeasterly waves reaching 1.5 to 2.0 meters (4 to 6 ft) and steady.

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Extended Forecast

Sunday to Thursday: mostly cloudy skies with occasional to intermittent showers in the early morning and early afternoon. **Rainfall is anticipated to be between 10 and 30 mm within 24 hours of accumulation.**
