

Weather Brief for Wednesday, 01 July 2026 from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana

Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00hrs Wednesday, 01 July 2026 were available for most of the stations. **De Kinderen Back in Region 3 recorded the highest rainfall of 77.1 mm.**

Severe Weather Advisory: Areas affected by thundershowers may experience strong wind gusts, heavy rainfall, and possible lightning strikes. Residents are advised to exercise caution during these conditions.

Marine Advisory: Due to spring tides in effect, overtopping of river and sea defence are likely. Persons in riverine and low-lying coastal areas are advised to take the necessary precautions.

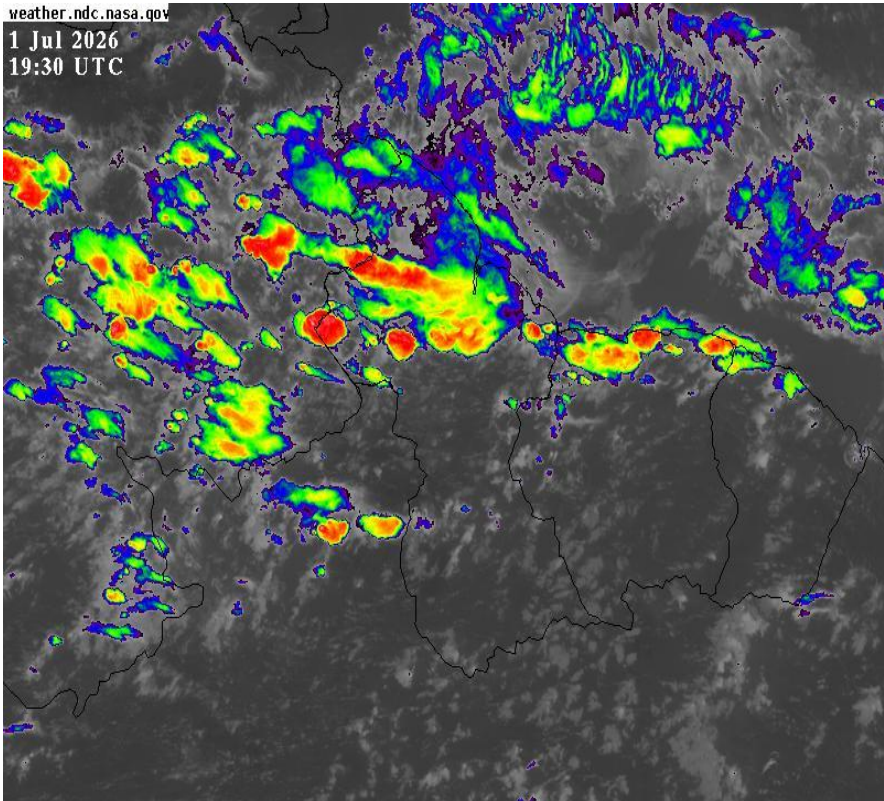
Synopsis: Low level troughs with ITCZ produced instabilities over most of northern Guyana. Elsewhere weak instabilities from localized effects. Similar atmospheric conditions are projected for the next 2 days, after which a Tropical wave embedded with the ITCZ is likely to produce instabilities over the forecast area.

Today’s weather review: Region 8, 9 and southern 6 observed partly cloudy and sunny skies with isolated showers and thundershowers. Regions 1 to 3 and 7 observed cloudy to overcast skies with rain and scattered thundershowers. Elsewhere partly cloudy and sunny skies becoming cloudy with scattered showers and isolated thundershowers.

Spring Tide Advisory: The Spring Tide is in effect.

Sea conditions:

- Slight to moderate northeasterly seas with swells reaching 1.5 to 2.0 meters in open waters.
- These waves will likely have periods of between 7 and 8 seconds.
- Moderate easterly breeze.

Extended Forecast

Friday and Monday: Mostly cloudy skies with occasional to frequent showers and isolated thundershowers. Rainfall is expected to be between 10 mm and 30 mm within 24 hours.

Saturday and Sunday: Cloudy to overcast skies with intermittent rain and isolated thundershowers. Rainfall is expected to be between 20 mm and 50 mm within 24 hours.

Tuesday: Mostly fair and sunny skies with isolated showers. Rainfall is expected to be between 0 mm and 10 mm within 24 hours.
