WEATHER BRIEF for Friday 03 July 2026, from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana-

Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00 hours on Friday, 03 July 2026, were available for some stations. Kwatamang in Region 9 recorded the highest rainfall of 92.2mm

SynopsisWeak instability in the atmosphere over Guyana today. Tonight, and the remainder of the weak, moisture surge from the Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) is expected to induce moderate instability over Regions 1 to 5, 7, 9 10 and North and South Region 6. In the other areas Weak instability.

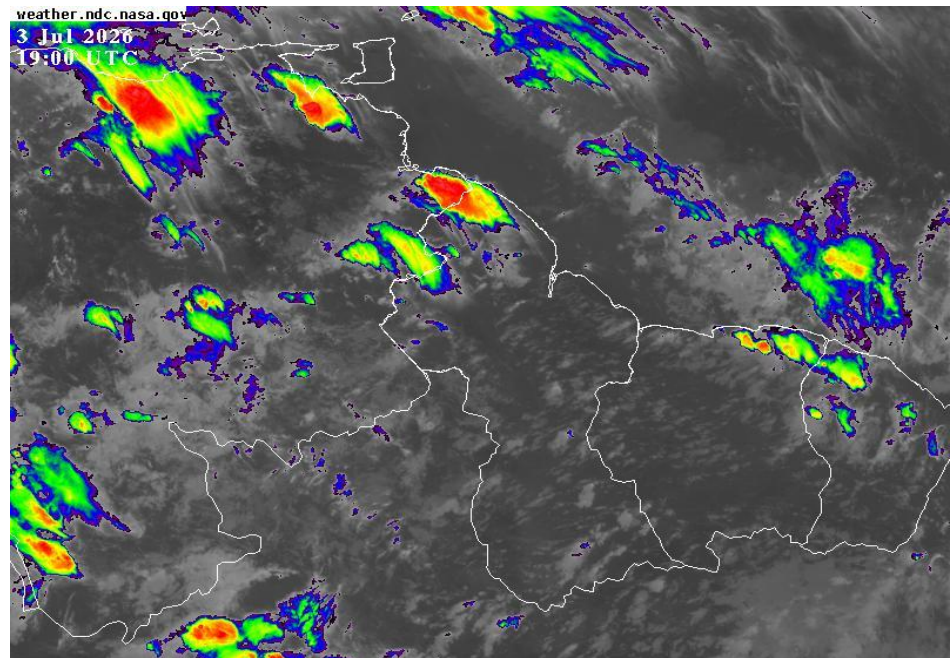
Weather review: Except for scattered showers over inland areas, mostly sunny skies dominated

Sunday, Monday and Tuesday: Early morning showers along coastal areas of Region 3 to 5. In the other areas no significant rainfall. For the remainder of the forecast period, except for scattered showers, mostly sunny skies is expected to dominate. **Rainfall is expected to range between 0 and 20mm.**

Wednesday and Thursday: Partly cloudy to cloudy with occasional to frequent showers in Regions 1 to 5 in the morning. Elsewhere, no significant rainfall. For the remainder of the of the forecast period, except for scattered showers, mostly sunny skies. **Rainfall is expected to range between 0 and 30mm.**
