Severe Weather Advisory: Areas affected by thundershowers will experience strong wind gusts, brief periods of intense rainfall, and possible lightning strikes. Residents are advised to exercise caution during these conditions.

Marine Advisory: High surface winds may produce choppy to rough seas, making navigation difficult for small vessels and fisherfolk. Operators are advised to exercise caution as winds of up to 20 knots are expected over open waters.

Track-F- Bydarabu in Region 7 recorded the highest rainfall of 96.1 mm

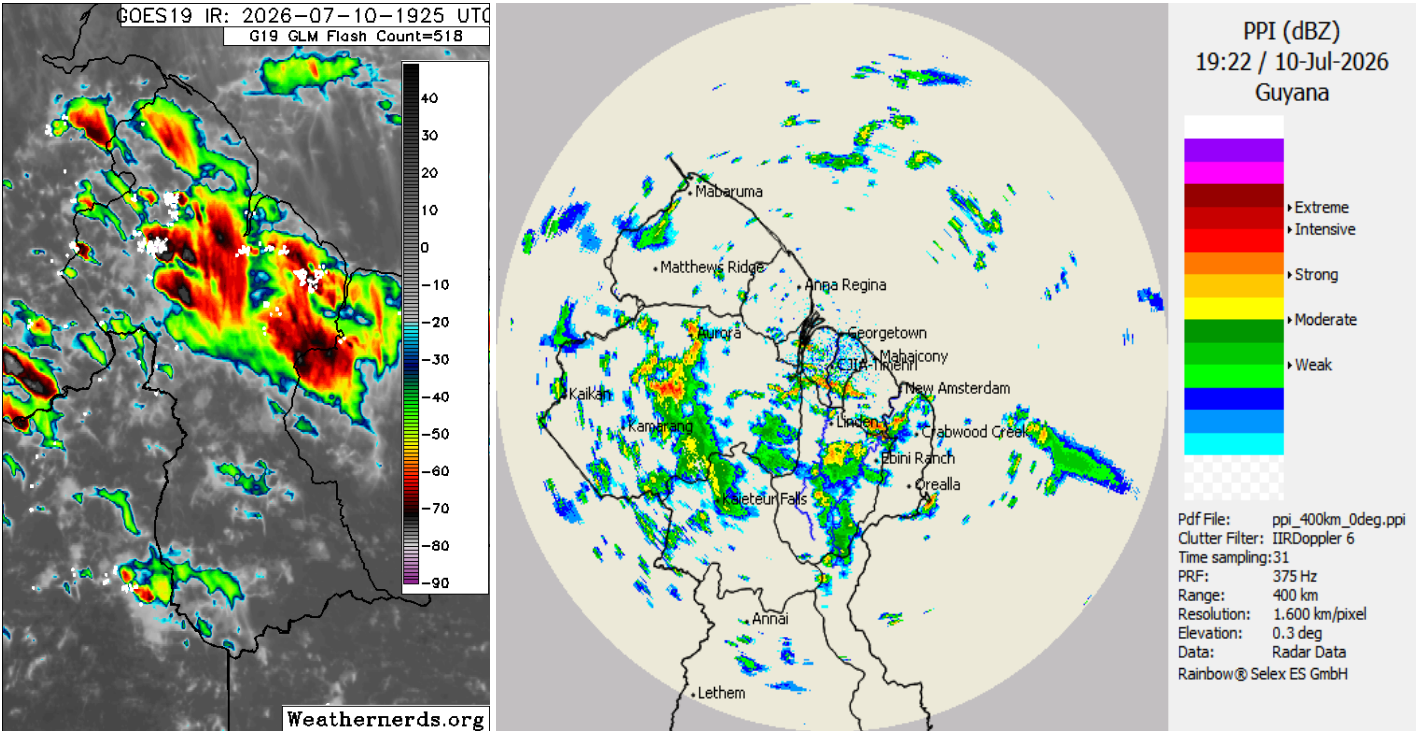
Synopsis: Unstable conditions driven by strong confluencing ahead of a Tropical Wave are affecting Guyana.

Sea conditions:

Open waters are expected to be moderate to rough with northeasterly swells reaching 2.0 to 3.0 meters (6 to 8 feet) and steady.

- Wave periods will range between 8 and 9 seconds.
- Moderate to Fresh easterly breeze.

Extended Forecast

Sunday: Mostly cloudy skies with scattered to occasional morning showers. Rainfall between 10 and 20 mm.

Monday, cloudy to overcast skies with intermittent to frequent showers and isolated thunderstorms. Rainfall between 20 and 45 mm.

Tuesday to Thursday, sunshine and clouds with scattered showers. Rainfall between 0 and 15 mm.
