

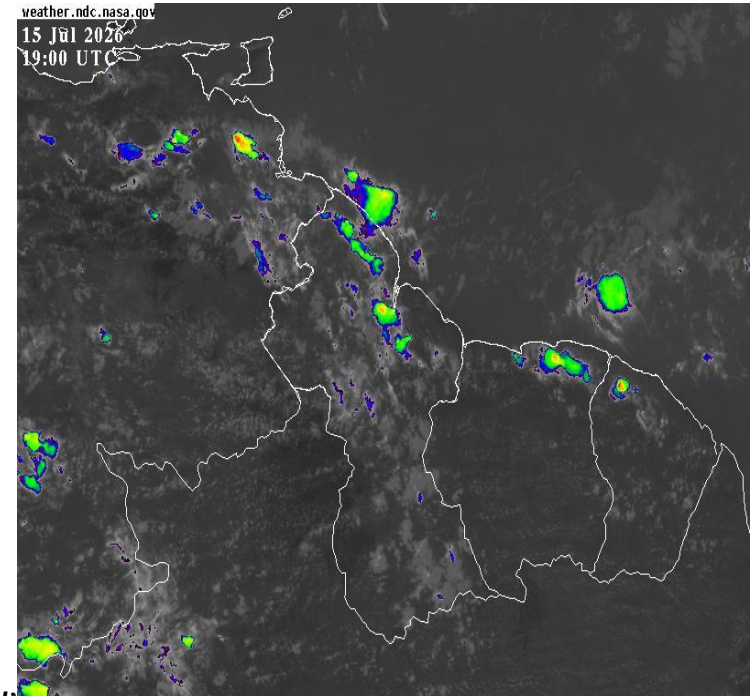

WEATHER BRIEF for Wednesday 15 July 2026, from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana  
*Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00 hours on Wednesday, 15 July 2026, were available for some stations. Wakapoa in Region 2 recorded the highest rainfall of 21.0mm*  
**Synopsis:** Pulses of moisture from the Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ), are generating weak to moderate instability over Guyana, and is expected to continue for the remainder of the Week.  
**Weather review:** Partly cloudy to cloudy with scattered showers over inland areas. Elsewhere, no significant rainfall.

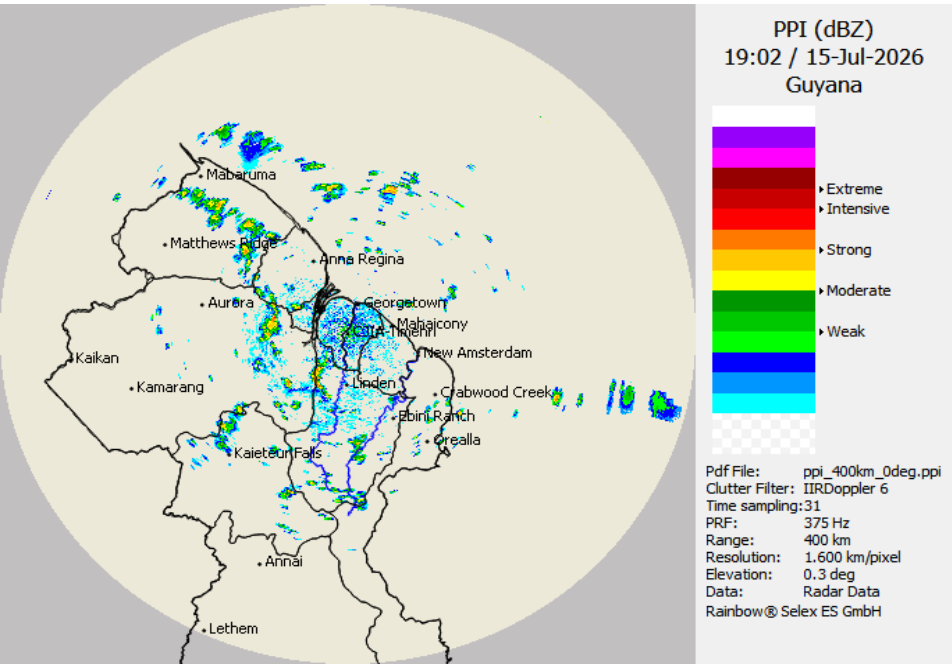
*Georgetown's long-term daily average rainfall for the next 10 days, 15 July to 24 July 2026, is 10.0mm per day.*

**SPRING TIDE ADVISORY: It is in effect.**

**SEA CONDITIONS:** Moderate in open waters with North-easterly swells reaching 1.0 to 2.0 meters (3 to 6ft) and increasing.,

These waves will likely have periods of 7 and 8 seconds,

**Winds:** Light to Gentle Northeast breeze.

**Friday:** Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with scattered to occasional showers over coastal areas of Regions 1 to 5 Elsewhere no significant rainfall, in the morning. For the remainder of the forecast period, Regions 7, 8 and 10 can expect occasional showers. In the other areas, mostly sunny skies. **Rainfall is expected to range between 5 and 20mm.**

**Saturday through Tuesday:** Occasional showers over Regions 1 and 2. Elsewhere scattered showers in the morning. For the remainder of the forecast period, except for scattered showers, over inland areas, mostly sunny skies will dominate. **Rainfall is expected to range between 0 and 15mm.**
