**Weather Brief for Wednesday, 02 July 2025 from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana.**

Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00hrs Wednesday, 02 July 2025 were available for most of the stations. **Kumu in Region 9 recorded the highest rainfall of 47.3 mm**

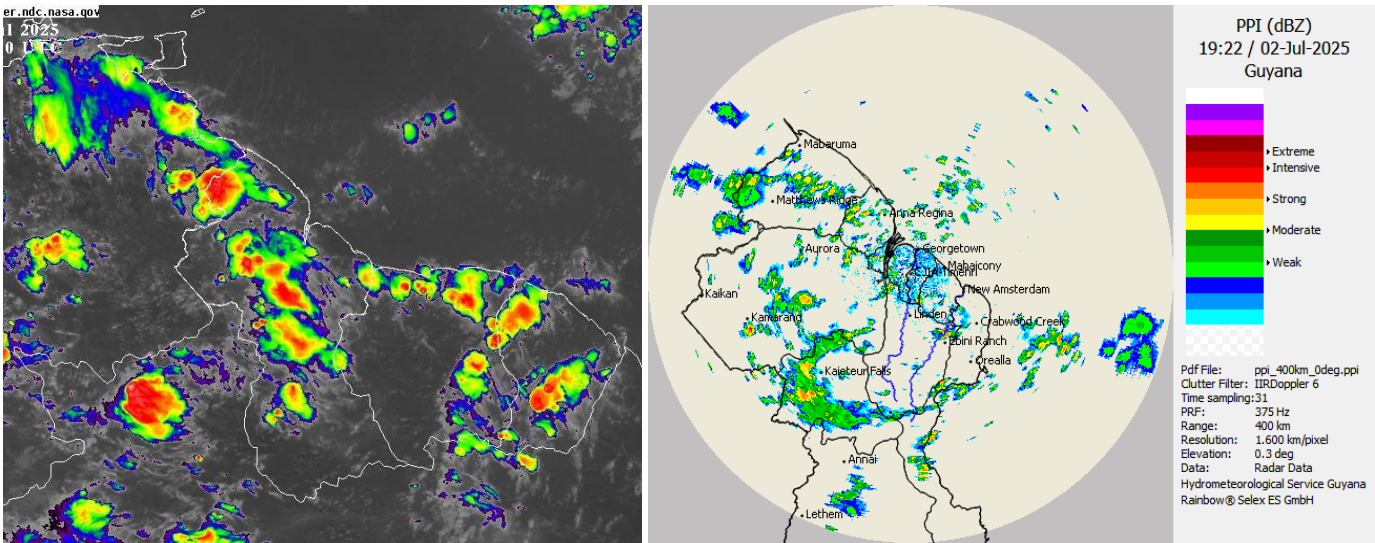
**Synopsis:** Low-level confluenting and moderate instabilities ahead of Tropical Wave #9 are affecting Guyana. This wave is expected to pass over Guyana between early morning and mid-morning, Thursday, affecting mostly northern Guyana. Southern Guyana will see small surface troughs oscillating across the area tonight.

**Today's weather review:** Mostly cloudy skies with scattered to occasional showers and isolated thundershowers were observed throughout Guyana.

Coastal areas will see scattered to occasional showers in the early morning.  <u>Winds:</u> Moderate east to southeasterly breeze becoming windy before and during heavy downpours and thundershowers.  <u>Minimum temperatures:</u>  Coast: 23 °C – 25 °C  Hinterland: 20 °C – 23 °C	Regions	Weather Conditions	Cloudy skies will continue across Northern Guyana with intermittent showers over coastal areas in the morning. In the afternoon, areas within regions 1, 7, and 8 will see thundershowers. Southern Guyana will see fair and sunny skies throughout the day.  <u>Winds:</u> Moderate easterly to southeasterly breeze becoming windy before and during heavy downpours and thundershowers.  <u>Maximum temperatures:</u>  Coast: 28 °C – 31°C  Hinterland: 30 °C – 33 °C
Regions 1 to 10	 <b>Rainfall is expected between 30 and 50 mm over regions 6 to 10 and between 10 and 25 mm over coastal areas.</b>		Regions 1 to 10	 <b>Rainfall is expected between 20 and 40 mm over northern Guyana, and elsewhere, no significant rainfall.</b>	

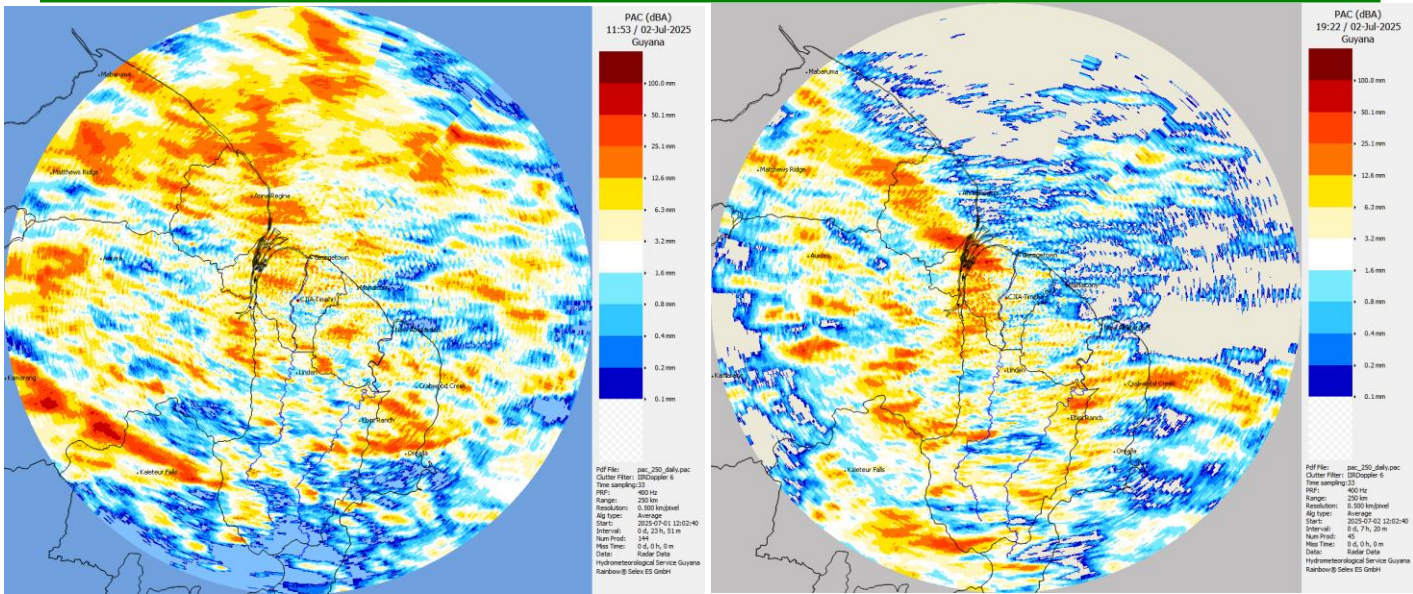
The long-term daily average rainfall for Georgetown, for the next 10 days July 3, 2025, to July 12, 2025, is 10.4 mm per day.

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Radar-generated precipitation estimates. Twenty-four and nine hours of rainfall are valid 8 hrs and 15 hrs on the Wednesday, 02 July 2025.

Sea conditions:

Slight to moderate in open waters with northeasterly to easterly waves reaching 1.0 to 2.0 meters (3 to 5 ft) and steady.

- These waves will likely have periods of between 7 and 8 seconds.
- Gentle to moderate Northeast to Easterly breeze.

Extended Forecast

Friday: Mostly fair and sunny skies can be expected throughout Guyana, with thundershowers from late morning to mid-afternoon over coastal areas. **Rainfall is anticipated between 10 to 20 mm in areas of thundershowers; elsewhere, no significant rainfall is likely.**

Saturday to Tuesday: Occasionally cloudy skies can be expected across Guyana with scattered showers during the early morning and isolated thundershowers in the early afternoon. **Rainfall is anticipated between 10 to 20 mm within 24 hours of accumulations.**
