WEATHER BRIEF for Monday 01 June 2026, from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana-

Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00 hours on Monday, 01 June 2026, were available for some stations. Bartica, St Cuthbert's Mission in Region 4 recorded the highest rainfall of 128.9 mm.

Synopsis: Pockets of moisture from the Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) induced low to mid-level convergence mostly over the coastal areas of Guyana, and are expected to continue for the remainder of the Week. Tropical Wave (Tw #7) is approaching and is expected to interact with the ITCZ, thus generating widespread deep convection over the forecast area in the next 3 to 4 days.

Weather review: Mostly cloudy with occasional showers and light rain over all Regions.

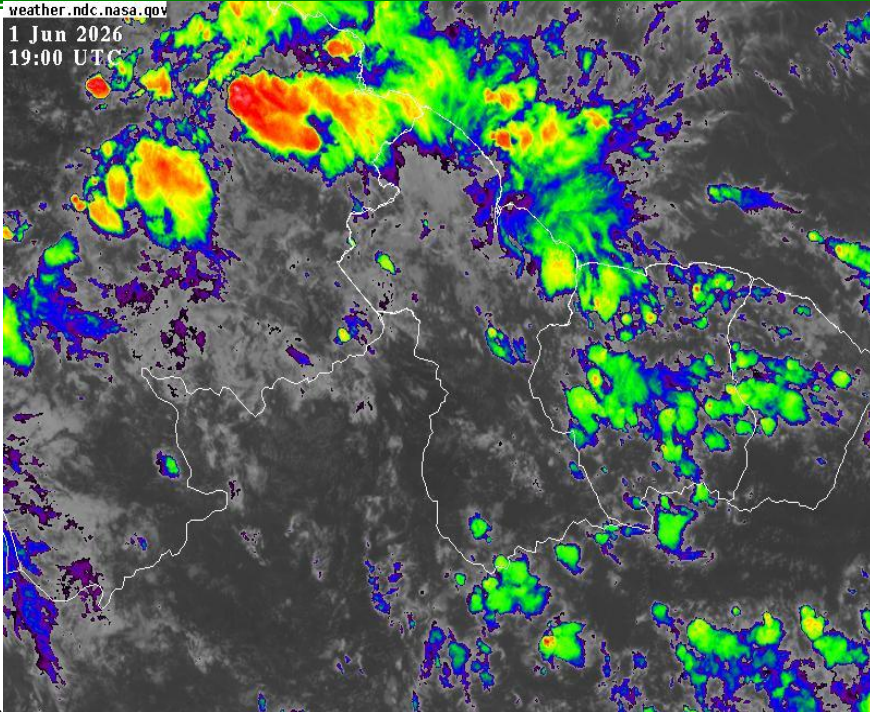

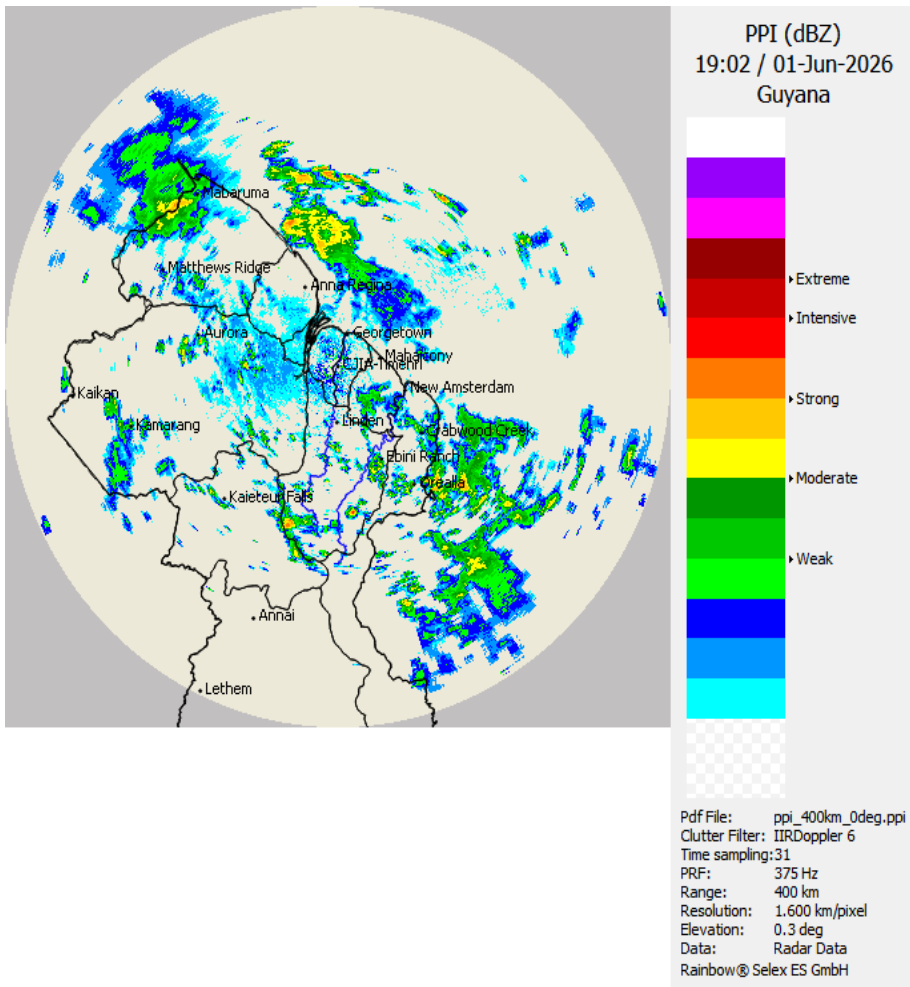
Georgetown's long-term daily average rainfall for the next 10 days, 01 June to 10 June 2026, is 10.0mm per day.

SPRING TIDE ADVISORY: *It is not in effect.*

SEA CONDITIONS: Moderate in open waters with North-easterly swells reaching 1.0 to 2.0 meters (3 to 6ft) and increasing.,

These waves will likely have periods of 7 and 8 seconds,

Winds: Gentle to moderate north-east to easterly breeze.

Wednesday: Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with occasional showers in coastal areas. In the other areas, scattered showers in the early morning. For the remainder of the forecast period, mostly cloudy with frequent showers, intermittent rain, and thundershowers, in Regions 1 to 3. Elsewhere, scattered to occasional showers. **Rainfall is expected to range between 20 and 70mm. in Regions 1 to 3. Elsewhere, 10 and 15mm elsewhere.**

Thursday and Friday: Cloudy with frequent showers in Regions 2 to 4. Elsewhere, partly cloudy to cloudy with scattered showers in the morning. For the remainder of the forecast period, partly cloudy, occasionally sunny with scattered showers. **Rainfall is expected to range between 10 and 40mm. The maximum is along the coastal areas of Regions 2 to 4.**

Saturday and Sunday: Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with scattered showers in the early morning. For the remainder of the forecast period. Regions 1 to 5 and the North Region 6 can expect frequent showers and thundershowers. **Rainfall is expected to range between 20 and 40mm in Regions 1 to 5 and North Region 6. Elsewhere, between 10 and 20mm.**
