WEATHER BRIEF for Tuesday, 03 June 2025, from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana-
Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00hrs on Tuesday, 03 June 2025, were available for some stations. Mahdia in Region 8 recorded the highest rainfall of 61.0mm

Synopsis: Weak to moderate instabilities continued to affect Guyana, as the Intertropical Convergence Zone(ITCZ) continues to dump plumes of moisture in the area. Tropical Wave (Tw3) is approaching Guyana and is expected to interact with the ITCZ, thus inducing atmospheric instabilities. The wave axis should be in the forecast area by Saturday or Sunday.

Today's Weather review: Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with occasional showers in regions 7, 8, 10, and inland areas of Regions 1 and 2. Elsewhere, except for brief showers, mostly sunny skies.

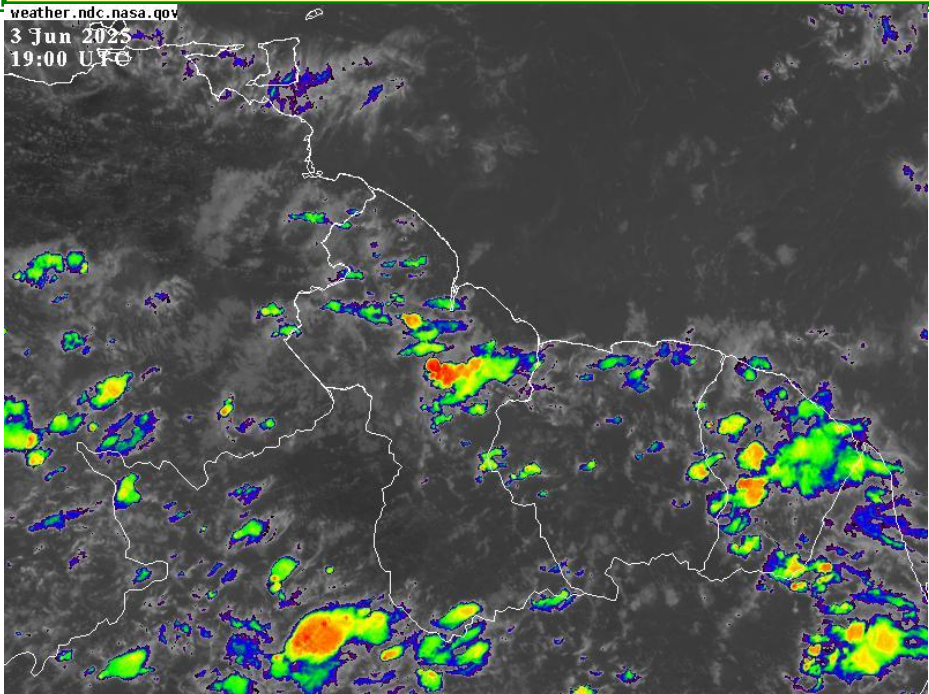

Georgetown's long-term daily average rainfall for the next 10 days, 03 June to 12 June 2025, is 11.2mm per day.

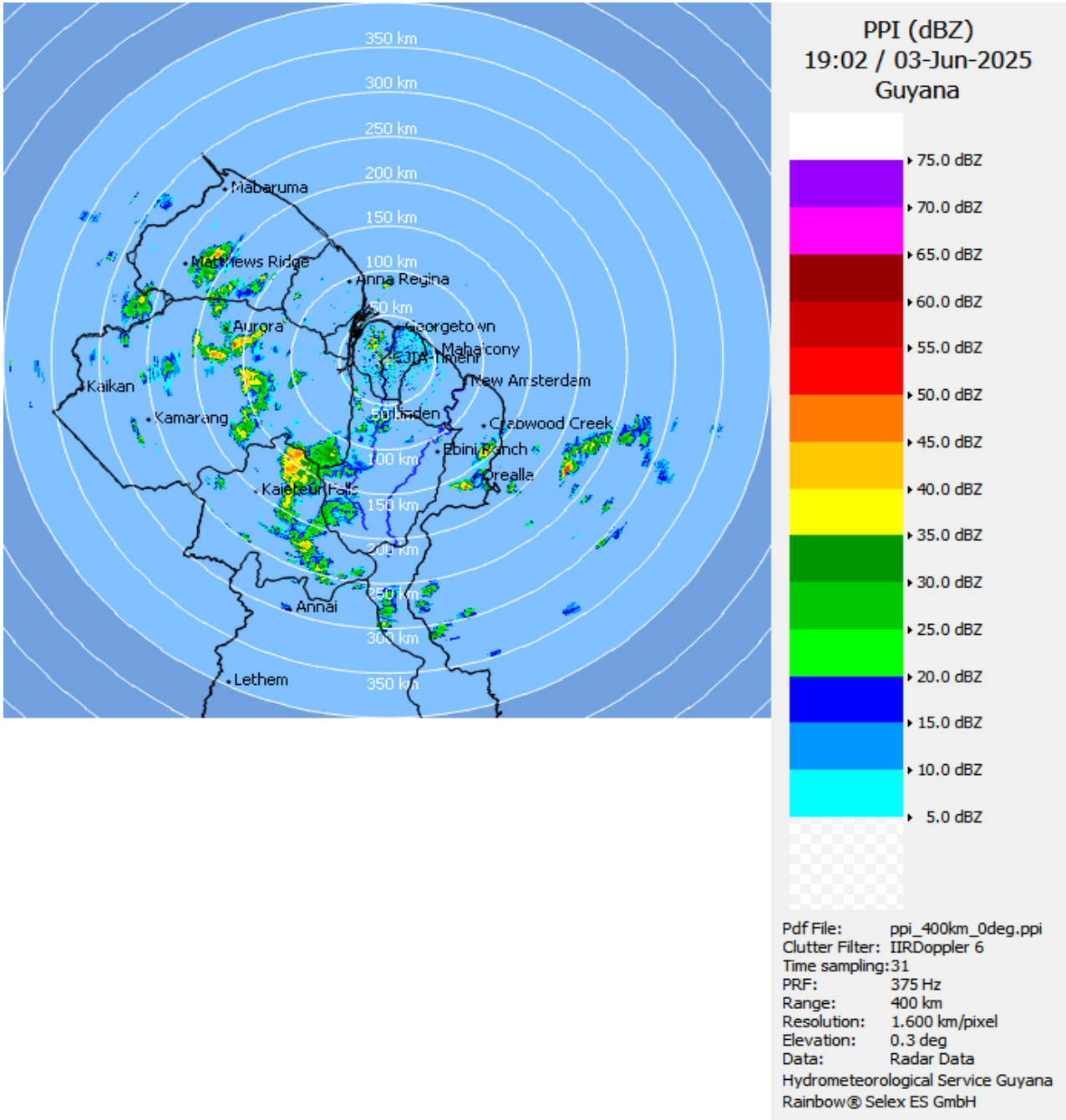
Weather Warnings: .

SEA CONDITIONS: Slight to moderate Easterly seas, with swells reaching 1.5 to 2.0 meters in open waters. Waves will likely have periods of between 7 and 8 seconds.

Winds: Light to Gentle to North-easterly to Easterly breeze.:

Thursday and Friday: Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with scattered to occasional showers, in all the Regions. Rainfall between 0 and 15 mm, the maximum in Regions 1 to 4, 7, and 10.

Saturday and Sunday: Cloudy to overcast with frequent showers, intermittent rain and thundershowers, in Regions 1 to 5, 7, 10, and North Region 6. Elsewhere, partly cloudy to cloudy with scattered to occasional showers. Rainfall between 20 and 80mm, in Regions 1 to 5, 7, 10, and North Region 6. In the other areas, between 10 and 20mm.

Monday: Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with scattered showers in the coastal areas. Elsewhere, partly cloudy and sunny with brief showers.
