WEATHER BRIEF for Tuesday 09 June 2026, from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana-

Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00 hours on Tuesday, 09 June 2026, were available for some stations. Bartica, Crabwood Creek in Region 6 recorded the highest rainfall of 22.4mm.

Synopsis: Weak atmospheric instabilities are currently affecting Guyana. A gradual regeneration and strengthening of the Inter-Tropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) is forecast to oscillate across the country from tomorrow, reintroducing unstable weather conditions and increasing moisture availability..

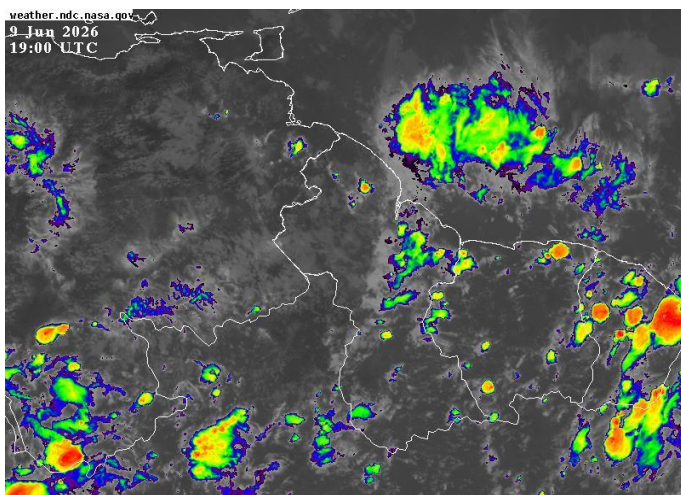
Weather review: Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with scattered showers in all the Regions.

SEA CONDITIONS: Moderate in open waters with North-easterly swells reaching 1.0 to 2.0 meters (3 to 6ft) and increasing.,

These waves will likely have periods of 7 and 8 seconds,

Winds: Gentle to moderate north-east to easterly breeze.

Thursday: In the early morning, mostly cloudy skies with frequent showers and thundershowers in Regions 8, 9, and South Region 6. Elsewhere, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with scattered showers. For the remainder of the forecast period, Regions 1 to 5 and the North Region 6 can expect occasional showers. In the other areas, scattered showers, **Rainfall expected to range between 30 and 60mm in Regions 8, 9, and South Region 6. Elsewhere, 10 and 20mm.**

Friday through Monday: Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with scattered to occasional showers in coastal areas in the morning and other areas for the remainder of the forecast period. **Rainfall expected to range between 10 and 20mm.**
