**WEATHER BRIEF for Friday 12 June 2026, from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana-**

*Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00 hours on Friday, 12 June 2026, were available for some stations. **West Watooka in Region 10 recorded the highest rainfall of 94.3mm.***

**Synopsis:** Today, the atmosphere is mostly stable over all Regions. The stability is expected to continue for the remainder of the week and early Sunday morning, except for local convection, which may generate some rainfall. Another Tropical wave is approaching Guyana and is expected to interact with the Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ). The synoptic models indicate an increase in rainfall, beginning late Sunday and continuing into early Tuesday, unless there is a change in atmospheric dynamics.

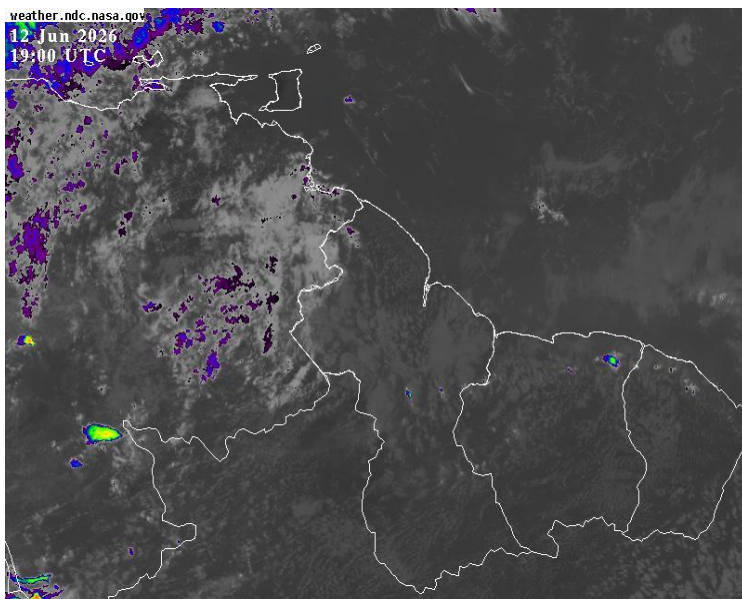
**Weather review:** *Mostly sunny skies, no significant rainfall.*

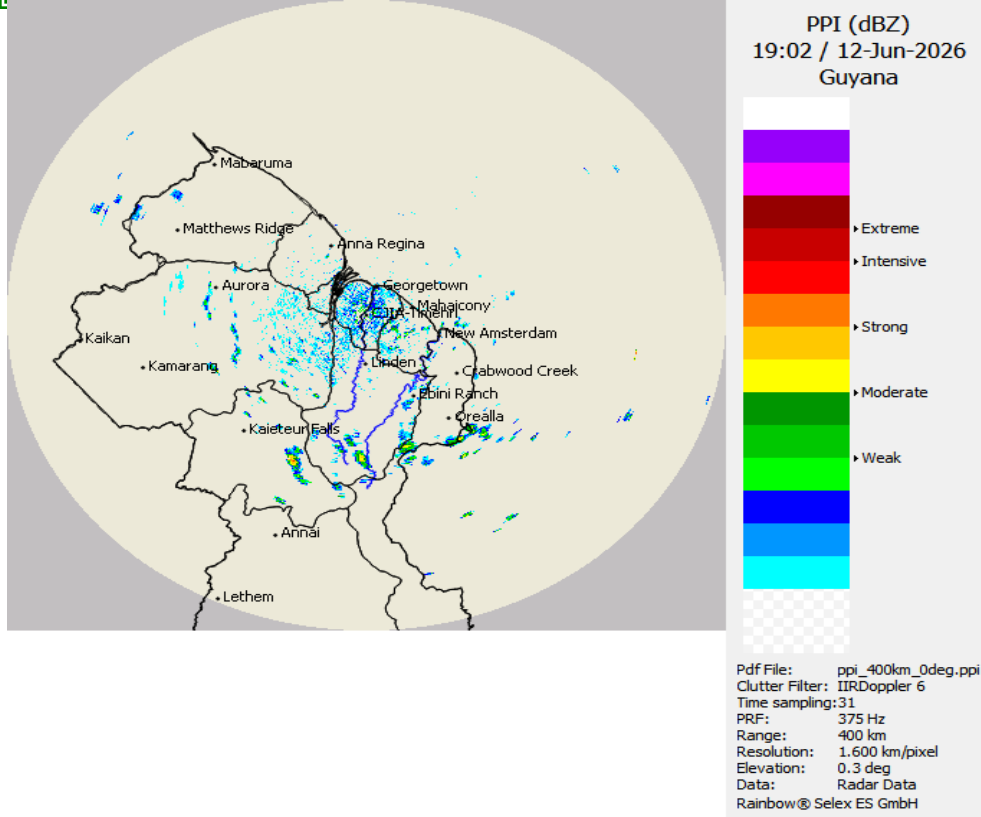
**Weather Warning:** **In areas of thundershowers, heavy winds and lightning strikes are likely to be observed.**

**Winds:** Gentle to moderate north-east to easterly breeze.

**Sunday and Monday: Cloudy to overcast skies, with frequent showers, light rain, and thundershowers in Regions 1 to 5, 7, 10, and North Region 6. Elsewhere, partly cloudy with scattered showers. **Rainfall is expected to range between 20 and 60mm in Regions 1 to 5, 7, 10, and North Region 6. In the other areas, 0 and 10mm.****

**Tuesday through Thursday: Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with scattered to occasional showers in all of the Regions. **Rainfall expected to range between 0 and 30mm.****
