**WEATHER BRIEF for Tuesday 16 June 2026, from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana-**

Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00 hours on Tuesday, 16 June 2026, were available for some stations. **De Kinderen Front in Region 03 recorded the highest rainfall of 79.4mm.**

**Synopsis:** The Intertropical Convergence (ITCZ) is dumping a lot of moisture in the forecast area, thus inducing low to mid-levels convergence and is being supported at the upper levels. Tropical Wave (Tw#16) is approaching Guyana. Atmospheric dynamic is showing the wave having an inverted (V) pattern, the wave is expected to generate significant rainfall as it interacts with ITCZ.

**Weather review:** Cloudy to overcast with occasional to frequent showers, light rain and thundershowers over Regions 1 to 5, 7, 10 and North Region 6. Elsewhere scattered showers.

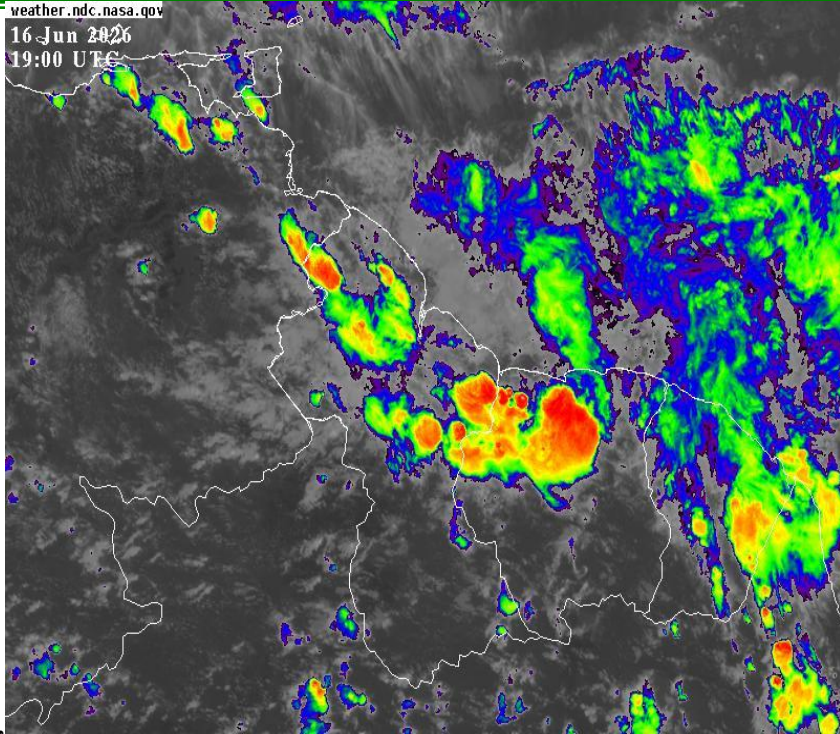

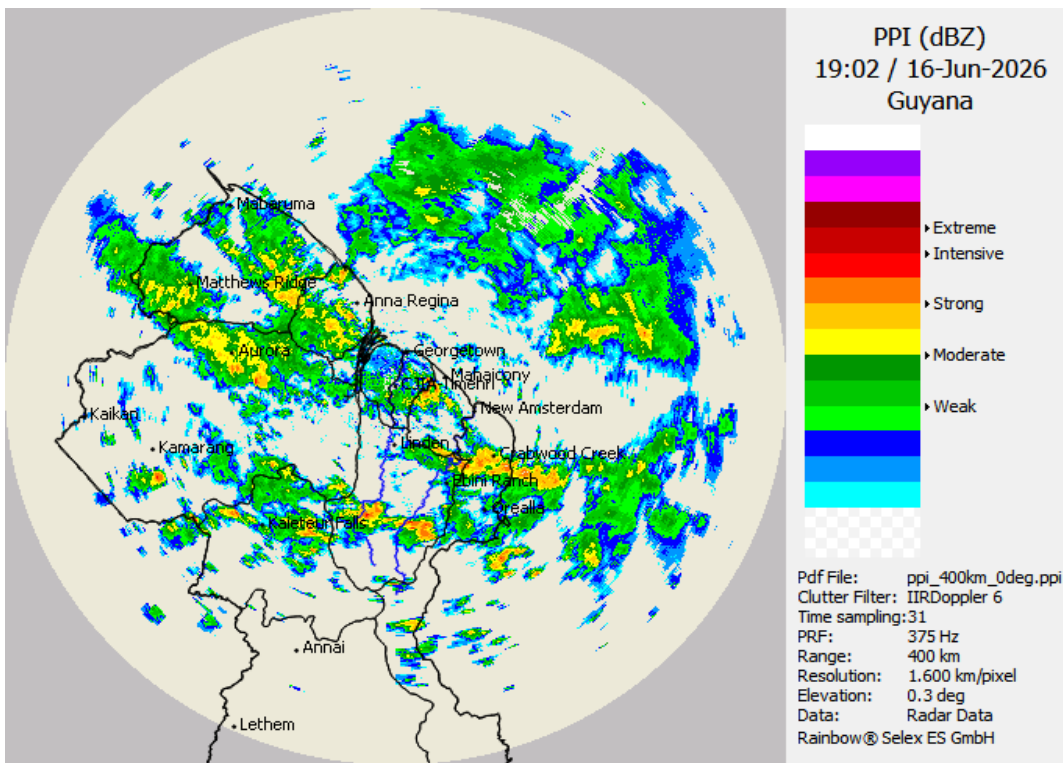
**Georgetown's long-term daily average rainfall for the next 10 days, 16 June to 25 June 2026, is 10.7mm per day.**

**SPRING TIDE ADVISORY: *It is in effect.***

**SEA CONDITIONS:** Moderate in open waters with North-easterly swells reaching 1.0 to 2.0 meters (3 to 6ft) and increasing.,

These waves will likely have periods of 7 and 8 seconds,

**Winds:** Gentle to moderate north-east to easterly breeze.

**Thursday:** Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with scattered to occasional showers in all of the Regions. **Rainfall expected to range between 10 and 30mm.**

**Friday:** Cloudy to overcast skies, with frequent showers, rain and thundershowers, in Regions 1 to 5, 7, 10 and North Region 6. Elsewhere, partly cloudy to cloudy with scattered to occasional showers. **Rainfall expected to range between 30 and 80mm in Regions 1 to 5, 7, 10 and North Region 6. Elsewhere, between 10 and 20mm.**

**Saturday through Monday:** Early morning scattered showers in all Regions. In the late morning and the remainder of the forecast period, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with scattered to occasional showers. **Rainfall is expected to range between 10 and 30mm.the maximum in Regions 7, 10 and North Region 6.**
