**WEATHER BRIEF for Tuesday 11, March 2025, from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana-**  
Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00hrs Tuesday, 11 March 2025, were available for some stations. **Hossororo in Region 1 recorded the highest rainfall of 21.6mm.**

**Synopsis:** Plumes of moisture continue to generate Weak to moderate instability over Guyana and are expected to continue for 24 to 36 hours.

**Today's Weather review:** Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with scattered showers over inland areas.

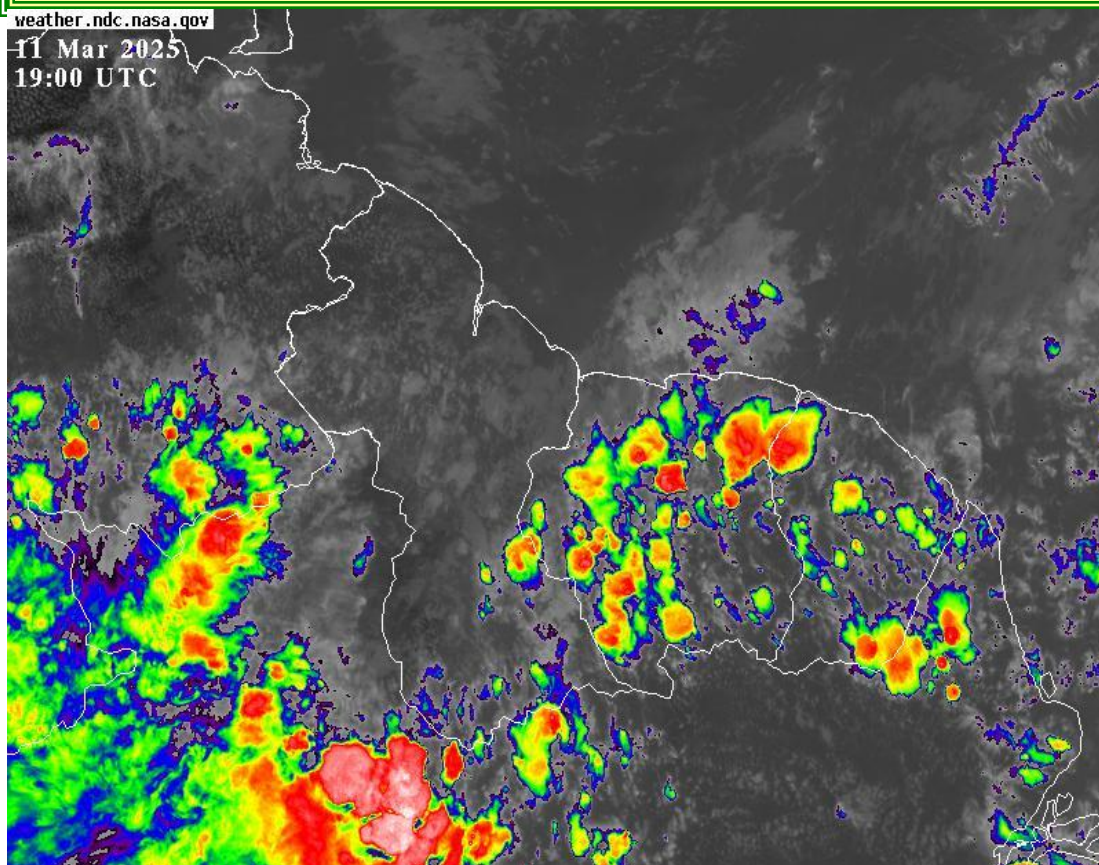

**SEA CONDITIONS:** Moderate from the Northeast, to Easterly with swells reaching 2.5 to 3.0 meters (6 to 9ft) in open waters.

These waves will likely have periods of between 7 and 9 seconds.

Winds: Gentle to Moderate Northeasterly to Easterly winds.

**Extended Forecast:**

**Thursday:** Cloudy to overcast with frequent showers, intermittent rain and thundershowers, over Region 9, Central and South Region 6, elsewhere, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with scattered to occasional showers, in the morning. In the afternoon, Region 9 and coastal areas of Regions 1 to 3 can expect frequent showers, and scattered showers elsewhere. **Rainfall is expected to range between 20.0 and 40.0 mm over Region 9, and coastal areas of Regions 1 to 3.**

**Friday through Monday:** Fair and sunny skies will be interrupted by scattered showers over all the Regions. **Rainfall is expected to range between 0.0 and 150 mm, the maximum over Regions 1, 2, Central and South Region 6.**
