**19, 2026WEATHER BRIEF for Saturday 07 March 2026, from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana-**  
Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00 hours on Saturday, 07 March 2026, were available for some stations. **Melville Wakenaam in Region 3 recorded the highest rainfall of 89.6mm**

**Synopsis:** The high-pressure ridge continues to be dominant, however local convection at the lower levels, are generating mild to moderate instabilities. The current feature is expected to continue into the new week.

**Weather review:** Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with occasional showers in Regions 7, 8, and 10. Elsewhere, scattered showers




**Georgetown's long-term daily average rainfall for the next 10 days, 07 March to 16 March 2026, is 4.5m per day.**

**Monday:** Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with scattered showers in the morning and early afternoon. In the late afternoon and the remainder of the forecast period, Region 7, Central and South Region 6 can expect frequent showers. Elsewhere, no significant rainfall. **Rainfall will range between 10 and 30 mm.**

**Tuesday:** Mostly fair and sunny skies may be interrupted by periods of cloudiness with scattered showers. **Rainfall will range between 0 and 15 mm.**

**Wednesday:** Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with scattered showers in the early morning. In the late morning, and the remainder of the forecast period, Regions 6, 10 and South Region 9, can expect frequent showers, Elsewhere, no significant rainfall. **Rainfall will range between 10 and 30 mm.**

**Thursday and Friday:** No significant rainfall in the early morning. For the remainder of the forecast period, partly cloudy to cloudy skies, with occasional showers in Regions 1 to 5 and North Region 65. In the other areas, scattered showers. **Rainfall will range between 10 and 30 mm.**
