**19, 2026 WEATHER BRIEF for Tuesday 10 March 2026, from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana-**  
Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00 hours on Tuesday, 10 March 2026, were available for some stations. De Edward Village in Region 5 recorded the highest rainfall of 14.3mm

**Synopsis:** Mild to moderate instabilities continue to dominate all Regions. Local convection and moisture intrusion from the South, induced low level convergence. In the mid and upper levels sinking motion is dominant.

**Weather review:** Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with frequent showers along inland areas. Elsewhere, scattered showers.




Georgetown's long-term daily average rainfall for the next 10 days, 10 March to 19 March 2026, is 3.2m per day.

**SEA CONDITIONS:** Moderate to rough in open waters with North-easterly swells reaching 2.0 to 3.0 meters (7 to 10 ft) and increasing.

These waves will likely have periods of 8 and 10 seconds

Winds: Moderate to fresh North-easterly to Easterly breeze.

**Thursday:** Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with occasional showers along Regions 7, 10 and North Region 6. In the other areas scattered showers. **Rainfall will range between 10 and 30 mm.**

**Friday:** In the early morning, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with scattered showers along coastal areas. In the other areas brief passing showers. In the late morning and the remainder of the forecast period, mostly cloudy with frequent showers, along Regions 1 to 4, 7, 10 Central Region 6 Elsewhere partly cloudy to cloudy with scattered showers. **Rainfall will range between 10 and 40 mm.**

**Saturday:** Early morning cloudy skies with scattered showers in Regions 2 to 4, and 7. Elsewhere partly cloudy with scattered showers. In the late morning and the remainder of the forecast period, cloudy to overcast skies with frequent showers, in Regions 7, South Regions 6 and 9. Elsewhere, partly cloudy to cloudy with scattered showers. **Rainfall will range between 10 and 40 mm.**

**Sunday and Monday:** Partly cloudy to cloudy with occasional showers along Regions 1 to 5 and 7. Elsewhere, scattered showers. **Rainfall will range between 10 and 30 mm.**
