Marine Advisory: A Small Craft and High Surf Advisory remains in effect as strong surface winds and high-energy waves continue to produce rough and hazardous sea conditions along the coast of Guyana. Fisherfolk, small craft operators, and other mariners are asked to exercise all necessary precautions.

Weather Brief for Sunday, 15 March 2026 from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana.

Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00 hours, are available for most of the stations.

Charity in Region 2 recorded the highest rainfall of 53.0 mm


Synopsis: Unstable atmospheric conditions continue to affect Guyana as shallow to moderate moisture plumes embedded within the northeasterly Tradewinds periodically move across the country. These moisture surges, combined with daytime heating and weak low-level instability, are producing intermittent cloudiness, scattered showers, and occasional brief periods of moderate rainfall. This unsettled pattern is expected to persist until late Tuesday. Thereafter, a gradual strengthening of a high-pressure ridge is anticipated to support more stable atmospheric conditions during the latter part of the week.

Today's weather review: Cloudy skies continued throughout Guyana with occasional showers and intermittent rain over coastal and inland areas.

Sea conditions:

Open waters are expected to be moderate to rough with northeasterly swells reaching 2.5 to 3.5 metres (7 to 10 feet) and steady.

- Wave periods will range between 8 and 9 seconds.
- Fresh northeast to easterly breeze.

Extended Forecast

Tuesday: Mostly cloudy skies with occasional showers. Rainfall is expected to be between 10 and 30 mm.

Wednesday to Saturday: a mix of sunshine and clouds across Guyana with scattered showers during the early afternoon. Rainfall is expected to be between 0 and 15 mm
