WEATHER BRIEF for Monday 04 May 2026, from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana-

Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00 hours on Monday, 04 May 2026, were available for some stations. Bartica Agriculture in Region 7 recorded the highest rainfall of 29.8mm.

Synopsis: Moisture plumes from the South of Guyana are being inhibited by the Sahara Air Layer (SAL), thus generating weak to moderate instability, and the growth of convective clouds.

Weather review: Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with occasional showers along inland areas. In the other areas, except for scattered showers, mostly sunny skies.

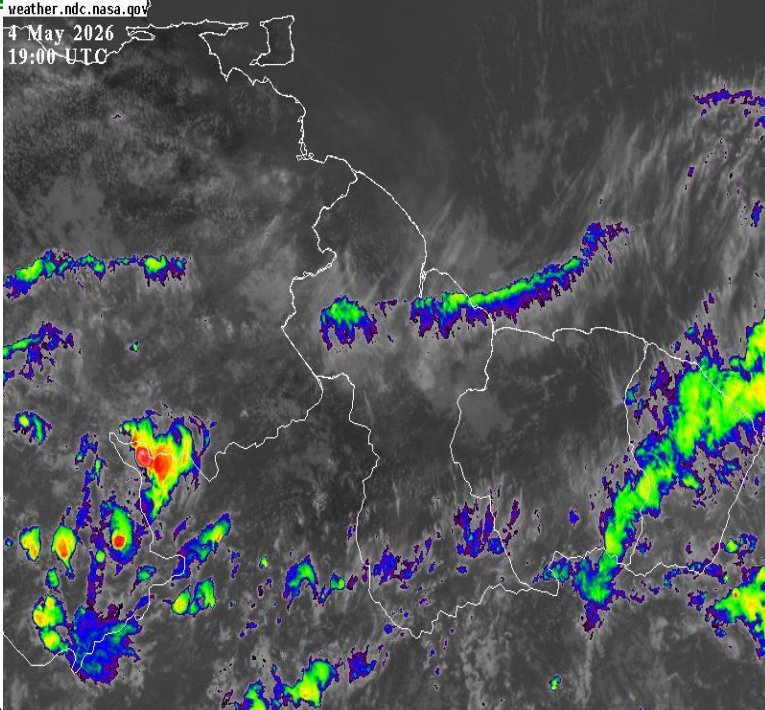

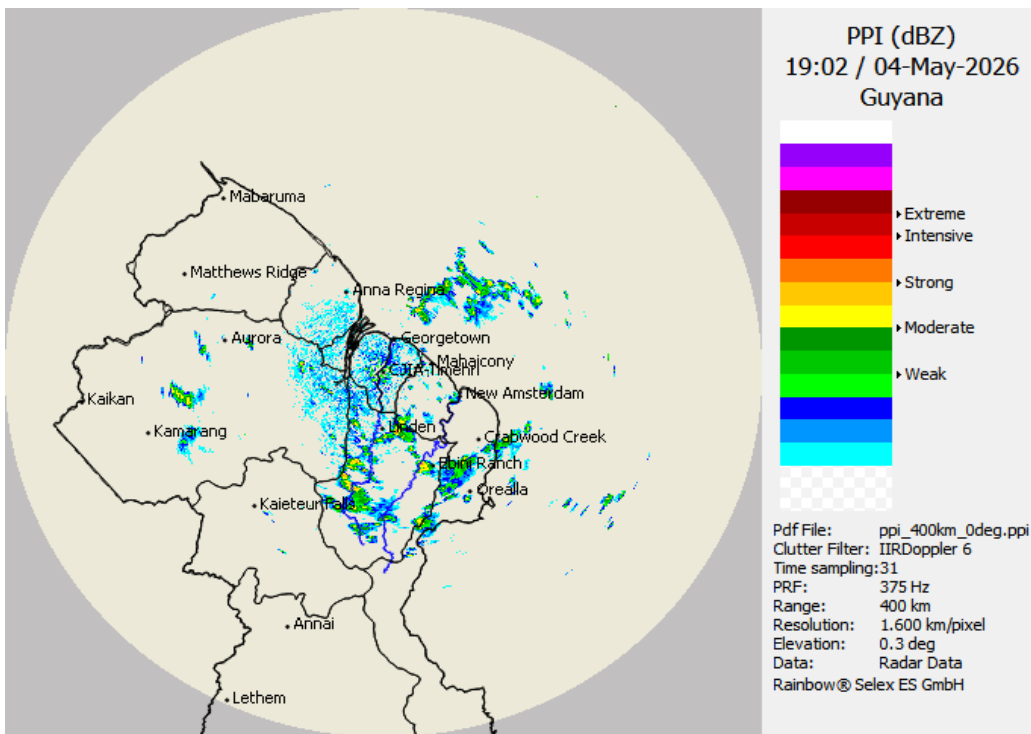
Georgetown's long-term daily average rainfall for the next 10 days, 04 to 13 May 2026, is 7.7m per day.

SEA CONDITIONS: Moderate in open waters with North-easterly swells reaching 1.0 to 2.0 meters (3 to 6ft) and increasing.,

These waves will likely have periods of 7 and 11 seconds

Winds: Light to gentle easterly breeze.

Wednesday: Mostly fair and sunny skies are expected to be interrupted by periods of cloudiness with scattered showers in all Regions. **Rainfall is expected to range between 0 and 15mm.**

Thursday: No significant rainfall in the early morning. For the remainder of the forecast period, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with occasional showers in South Regions 6 and 9. In the other areas, scattered showers. **Rainfall is expected to range between 10 and 40mm., The maximum is in South Region 6 and 9.**

Friday through Sunday: Early morning showers in South Regions 6 and 9. Elsewhere, no significant rainfall. For the remainder of the forecast period, except for scattered showers, mostly sunny skies. **Rainfall is expected to range between 0 and 15mm.**
