Weather Brief for Wednesday, 12 November 2025 from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana.
Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00hrs Wednesday, 12 November 2025 were available for most of the stations. **Track-F-Bydarabu in Region 7 recorded the highest rainfall of 81.1mm.**

Synopsis: Low to mid-level moisture plumes from the ITCZ are being enhanced by an upper-level trough and jet across Guyana. Forecast models show a continuation of these patterns for the remainder of the week.

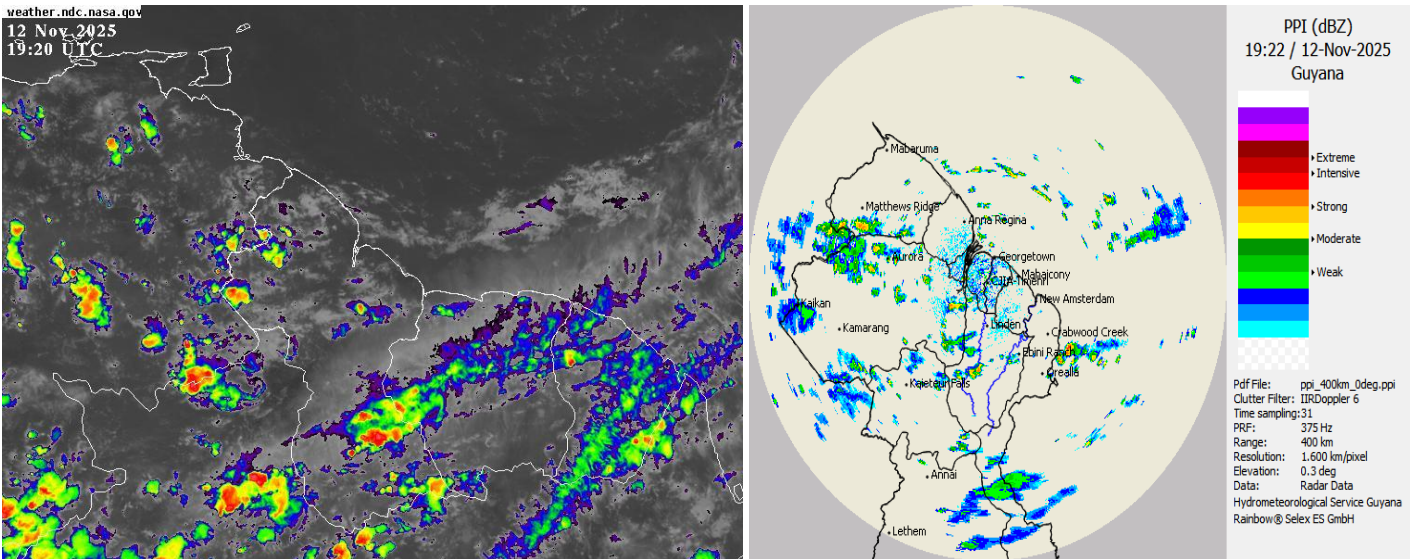
Today’s weather review: Mostly cloudy skies with scattered showers and intermittent rain were observed across Guyana.

The long-term daily average rainfall for Georgetown, for the next 10 days, November 13, 2025, to November 22, 2028, is 5.5 mm per day.

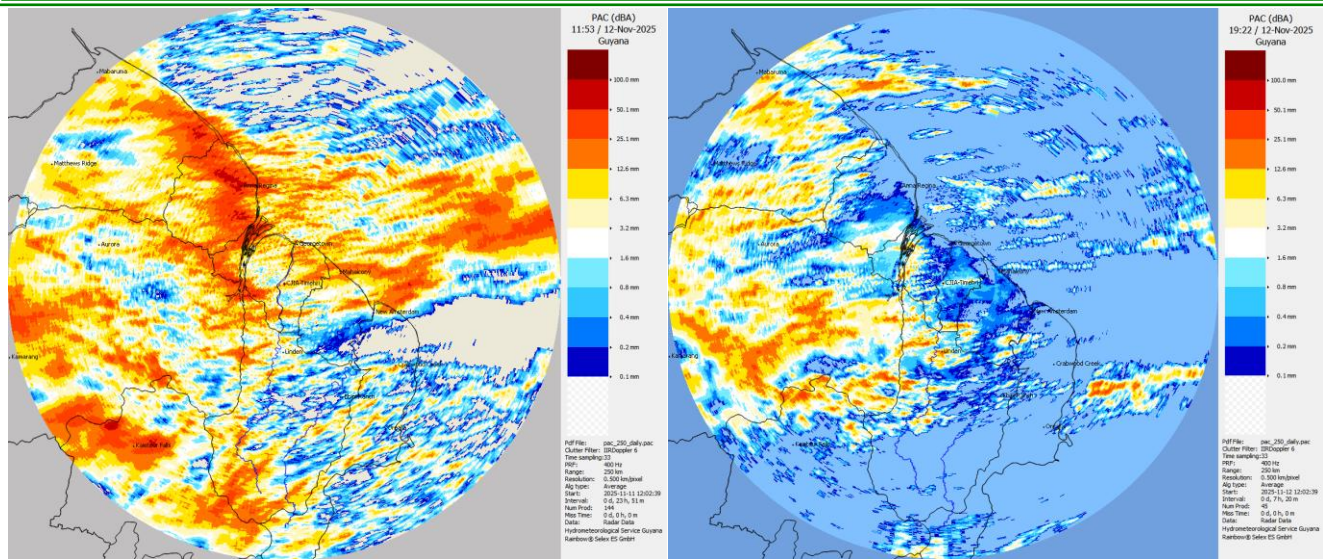
Severe Weather Warnings: In areas of thundershowers, heavy winds and lightning strikes may be observed.

Sea conditions:

Moderate in open waters with northeast to easterly swells reaching 1.5 to 2.5 meters (5 to 7ft) and steady.

- These waves will likely have periods of between 14 and 15 seconds.
- Moderate northeast to easterly breeze.

Extended Forecast

Friday: cloudy skies can be expected throughout Guyana with occasional showers over coastal and inland areas in the morning. Rainfall is expected to be between 10 and 30 mm.

Saturday: Fair to occasionally cloudy skies can be expected with brief to isolated showers. Rainfall is expected to be between 0 and 10 mm.

Sunday to Tuesday, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with scattered to occasional showers. Rainfall is anticipated to be between 0 and 25 mm.
