WEATHER BRIEF for Thursday 13 November 2025, from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana-
Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00 hours on Thursday, 13 October 2025, were available for some stations. Kumaka in Region 1 recorded the highest rainfall of 40.2mm.
Synopsis: Due to a shift in the upper-level Trough, an increase in subsidence and strong shear has resulted in some stability in the atmosphere. however, shallow moisture plumes from the ITCZ continue to move across Guyana. Forecast models show a continuation of these patterns for the remainder of the week.

Weather review: Partly cloudy to Cloudy with scattered to occasional showers in Regions 7, 10, and inland areas of Regions 1 to 3. Elsewhere, mostly sunny skies.

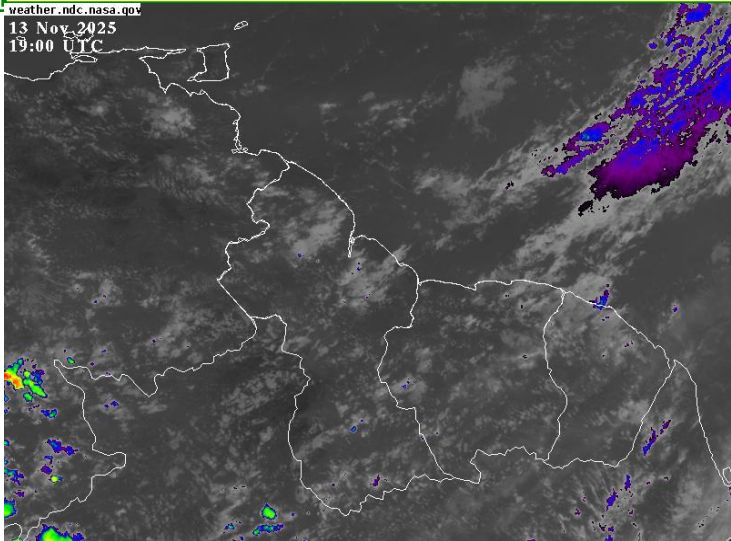

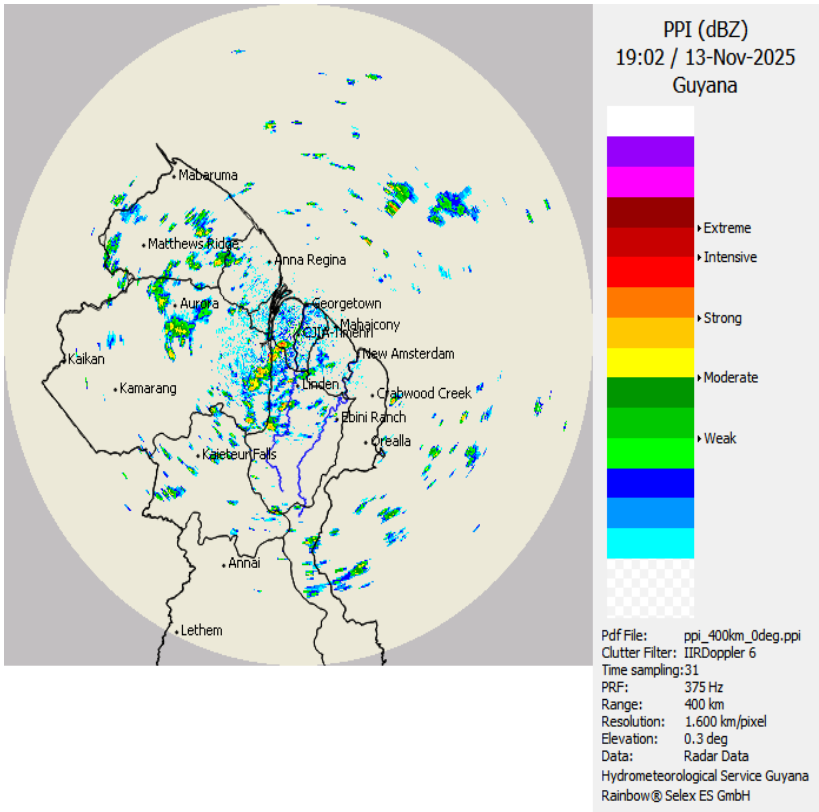
Georgetown's long-term daily average rainfall for the next 10 days, 13 to 22 November 2025, is 5.5mm per day.

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Friday: cloudy with occasional showers in Regions 1 to 4 and 10. Elsewhere, partly cloudy with scattered showers..
Rainfall is between 5 and 20mm.

Saturday and Sunday: No significant rainfall in the early morning. For the remainder of the forecast period, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with scattered showers in all of the Regions. **Rainfall is between 0 and 10mm.**

Monday: Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with no significant rainfall in the early morning. In the late morning and the remainder of the forecast period, cloudy to overcast skies with frequent showers in Region 10, North and Central Region 6. Elsewhere, partly cloudy to cloudy with scattered showers. **Rainfall is between 20 and 50mm. in Region 10, North and Central Region 6, in the other areas, between 10 and 15 mm.**

Tuesday and Wednesday: Cloudy to overcast skies with frequent showers and thundershowers in Regions 7, 10, and North Region 6. Elsewhere, can expect scattered to occasional showers.. **Rainfall is between 20 and 60mm. in Regions 7, 10, North Region 6, and in the other areas, between 10 and 20 mm.**
