WEATHER BRIEF for Thursday 14, November 2024, from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana-

Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00hrs Thursday, 14 November 2024, were available for some stations. Mahdia in Region 8 recorded the highest rainfall of 33.0 mm.

<u>Synopsis</u>: Southern Hemisphere influence and weak Inter Tropical Convergence Zone(ITCZ) generated weak to moderate instability over Guyana.

<u>Today's Weather review</u>: Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with brief showers over inland areas.



<u>Saturday</u>: Partly cloudy to cloudy with frequent showers and thundershowers over Region 9, Central and South Region 6 in the morning. In the other areas, brief showers. For the remainder of the day, all regions can expect brief showers. Rainfall is expected to range between 20.0 and 40.0 mm, over Region 9, Central and South Region 6, and elsewhere, 0.0 and 15.0 mm.

<u>Sunday</u>: Early morning showers and thundershowers over Region 9, and Central Region 6, in the other areas no significant rainfall. For the remainder of the day Regions 1 to 5, and North Region 6 can expect occasional showers, elsewhere, scattered showers. Rainfall is expected to range between 20.0 and 40.0 mm, over Region 9, and Central Region 6, elsewhere between 1.0 and 15.0 mm.

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Monday: Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with occasional showers over all Regions. Rainfall is expected to range between 15.0 and 20.0 mm, over Regions 7, 10, and North Region 6, elsewhere, between 10.0 and 15.0 mm.

<u>Tuesday and Wednesday</u>: Mostly cloudy with occasional showers over regions 1 to 5, 7, and 10, in the other Regions, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with scattered showers. Rainfall is expected to range between 15.0 and 20.0 mm, over Regions 1 to 5, 7, and 10, and elsewhere between 10.0 and 15.0 mm.
