WEATHER BRIEF for Monday 17 November 2025, from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana-

Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00 hours on Monday, 17 November 2025, were available for some stations. Wowetta in Region 9 recorded the highest rainfall of 22.4mm.

<u>Synopsis</u>: Today, Weak to moderate instabilities in Regions 7, 8, and 10. In the other Regions, mostly stable conditions. In the next 18 to 24 hours, the Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) is expected to generate significant moisture in the forecast area.

<u>Weather review</u>: Partly cloudy to cloudy with occasional showers in Regions 7, 8, and 10. Elsewhere, no significant rainfall.




Georgetown's long-term daily average rainfall for the next 10 days, 17 to 26 November 2025, is 6.5mm per day.

Rainfall is between 40 and 80mm. in Regions 1 to 3, 10, and the Central Region 6. Elsewhere, between 20 and 40mm.

<u>Wednesday and Thursday</u>: Cloudy to overcast skies with frequent showers, rain, and thundershowers in Regions 1 and 6 to 9. Elsewhere, occasional showers and intermittent rain. Rainfall is between 40 and 100mm. in Regions 1 and 6 to 9, in the other areas, between 20 and 40 mm.

<u>Friday through Sunday</u>: Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with occasional showers and intermittent rain in all of the Regions. Rainfall is between 15 and 40mm.
