**Weather Brief for Tuesday, 19 November 2024 from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana.**



Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00hrs Tuesday, 19 November 2024 were available for most of the stations.

**Mabaruma in Region 1 recorded the highest rainfall of 64.4 mm.**

Synopsis: Weak instabilities are affecting Guyana.

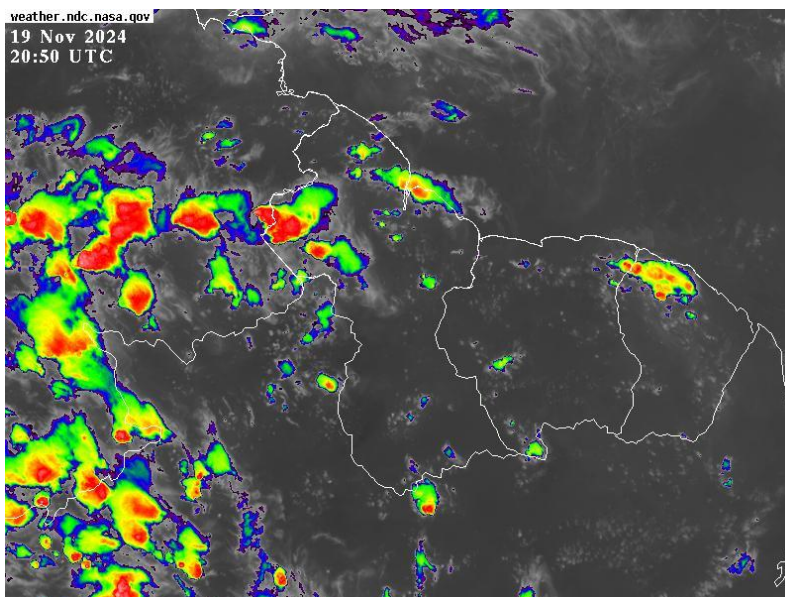
Today's weather review: a mix of sunshine and clouds with isolated afternoon thundershowers over regions 2 to 4, and 7.

The long-term daily average rainfall for Georgetown, for the next 10 days November 19 to November 28, 2024, is 6.9 mm per day.

**Severe Weather Warnings:** **In areas of thundershowers, heavy winds and lightning strikes are likely to occur. Persons are asked to exercise caution in efforts to safeguard life and property.**

Moderate in open waters with northeasterly waves reaching 1.0 to 2.0 meters (3 to 5 ft) and steady.

-These waves will likely have periods of between 7 and 11 seconds.

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Extended Forecast

Thursday and Friday: Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with afternoon thundershowers. Rainfall is anticipated between 0 to 20 mm within 24 hours of accumulations.

Saturday to Monday: Cloudy to overcast skies with occasional to frequent showers and isolated thundershowers. Rainfall is anticipated between 20 to 60 mm within 24 hours of accumulations.
