Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00hrs Saturday, 02 November 2024 were available for most of the stations. No significant rainfall was recorded.


Synopsis: High-pressure ridge remains the dominant feature.

Moderate in open waters with swells reaching 2.0 to 2.5 meters (5 to 7 ft) and increasing.

- -These waves will likely have periods of between 14 and 15 seconds.
- Gentle to moderate easterly breeze.

Extended Forecast

Monday to Friday: Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with a few brief showers. Rainfall between 0 to 15 mm within 24 hours of accumulation.
