WEATHER BRIEF for Saturday 22 November 2025, from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana-
Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00 hours on Saturday, 22 November 2025, were available for some stations. Hogg Island in Region 3 recorded the highest rainfall of 23.2mm.
Synopsis: Weak instabilities and shallow moisture were observed across Guyana. In the next 18 to 36 hours, the Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) is expected to induce convergence in the lower levels, mainly in coastal Guyana.
Weather review: Partly cloudy to cloudy with occasional showers and thundershowers in Regions 1, 2, 7, and 8. Elsewhere, scattered showers.

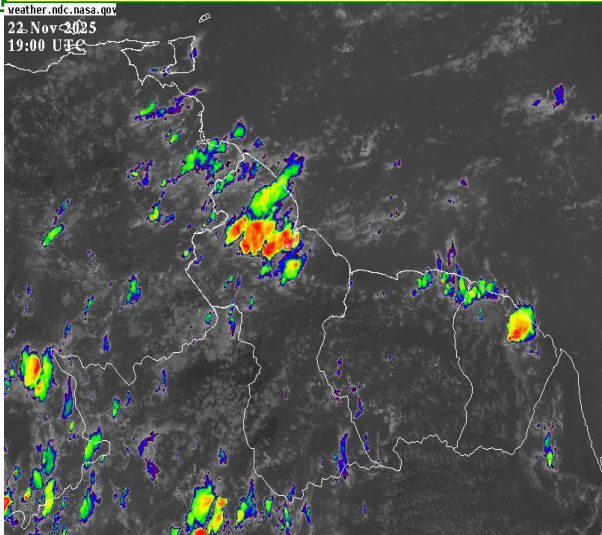

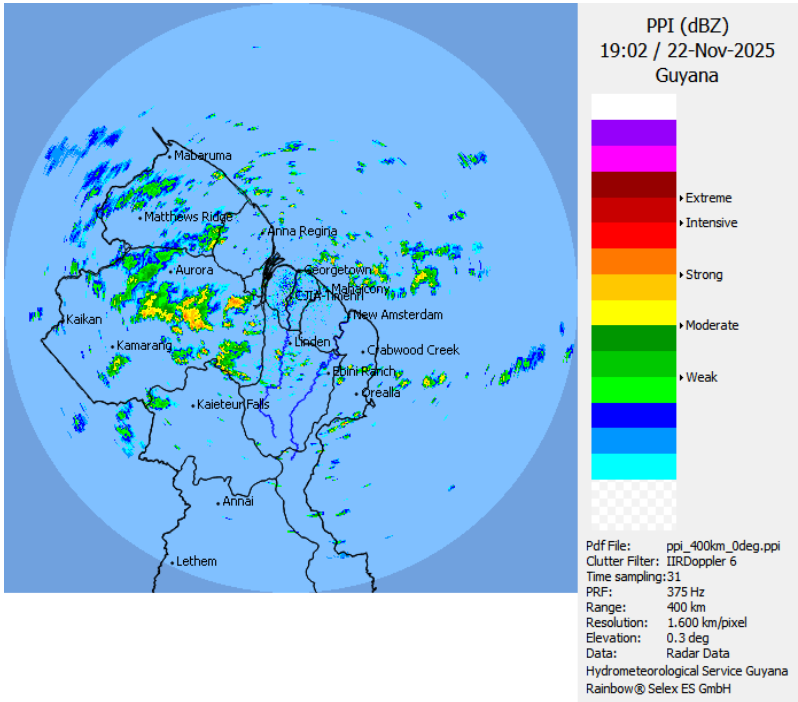
Georgetown's long-term daily average rainfall for the next 10 days, 22 to 01 December 2025, is 7.8mm per day.
