Weather Brief for Wednesday, 26 November 2025 from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana.

Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00hrs Wednesday, 26 November 2025 were available for most of the stations.

Fort Island in Region 2 recorded the highest rainfall of 30.8mm.

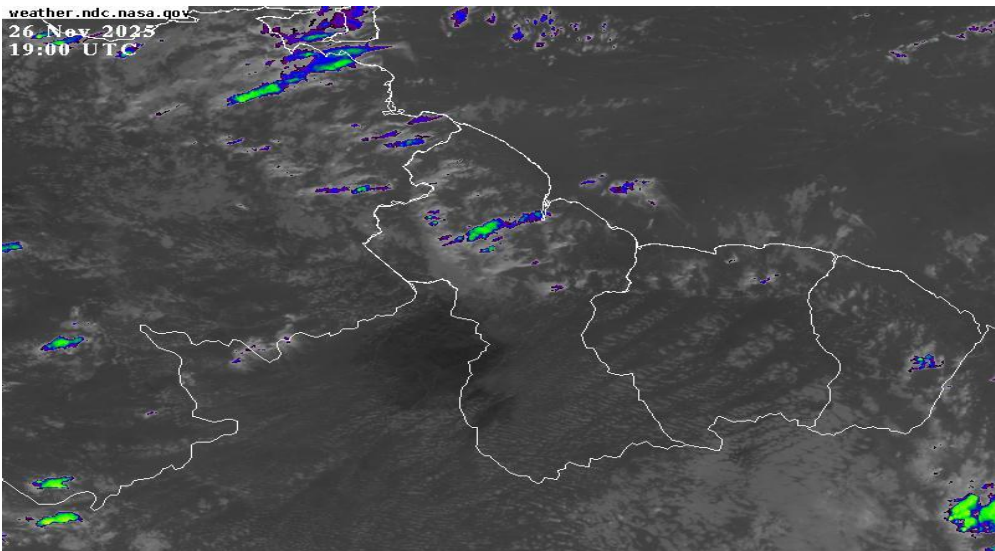
Synopsis: Weak instabilities driven by a weak low-level trough are affecting Guyana. Over the next few days, weak to moderate ITCZ influences can be expected.

Today's weather review: Fair to cloudy skies were observed across Guyana with scattered showers and isolated thundershowers.

The long-term daily average rainfall for Georgetown, for the next 10 days, November 28, 2025, to December 7, is 8.9 mm per day.

Sea conditions:

Moderate in open waters with northeasterly swells reaching 1.5 to 2.5 meters (5 to 7 ft) and steady.

- These waves will likely have periods of between 7 and 8 seconds.
- Moderate to Fresh northeast to easterly breeze.

Extended Forecast

Friday to Tuesday: Mostly cloudy skies with occasional to frequent showers and isolated thundershowers. Rainfall is anticipated to be between 10 and 40 mm within 24 hours of accumulation.
