Weather Brief for Thursday, 07 November 2024 from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana.

Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00hrs Thursday, 07 November 2024 were available for most of the stations. **Hibernia in Region 2 recorded the highest rainfall of 18.5 mm.**

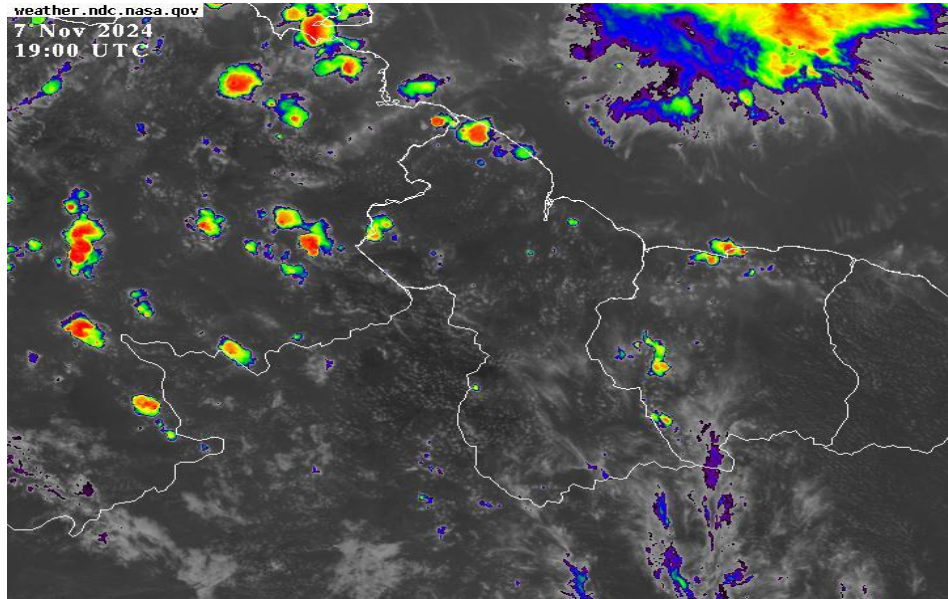
Synopsis: Weak instabilities are affecting Guyana.

Today's weather review: Except for brief passing showers over some coastal areas, mainly sunny skies were observed.

Sea conditions:

Moderate to rough in open waters with northeasterly swells reaching 2.5 to 3.0 meters (4 to 7 ft) and steady.

-These waves will likely have periods of between 7 and 9 seconds.

- Moderate to Fresh easterly breeze.

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Extended Forecast

Saturday and Sunday, partly cloudy to cloudy skies can be expected throughout Guyana with scattered showers. Rainfall is expected between 10 to 20 mm, highest over region 1.

Monday to Wednesday, mostly cloudy to occasionally overcast skies can be expected with occasional to intermittent showers. Rainfall is anticipated between 20 to 50 mm.
