WEATHER BRIEF for Wednesday 01 October 2025, from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana-

Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00 hours on Wednesday, 01 October 2025, were available for some stations. Saxicalli in Region 3 recorded the highest rainfall of 43.4mm

Synopsis: The ridge of high pressure is the dominant feature over Guyana. Mild to moderate instabilities driven by local convection will generate scattered cloud development

Weather review: Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with occasional showers in Regions 1, 2, and inland areas of Region 3. Elsewhere, except for scattered showers, mostly sunny skies.




Georgetown's long-term daily average rainfall for the next 10 days, 01 to 10 October 2025, is 2.4mm per day.

SEA CONDITIONS: Moderate Easterly South-easterly seas, with heights reaching 1.5 to 2.5 meters (5 to 7 ft) in open waters. Waves will likely have periods of between 5 and 8 seconds.

Winds: Light to Gentle Easterly to South-easterly breeze.

Friday and Saturday: Mostly fair and sunny skies are expected to be interrupted by scattered showers in coastal areas in the morning and in the remainder of the forecast period, in other areas. **Rainfall is between 0 and 15mm.**

Sunday through Tuesday: Partly cloudy to cloudy skies in the early morning with occasional showers in Regions 8 and 9. Elsewhere, no significant rainfall. For the remainder of the forecast period, mostly sunny skies are expected to be interrupted by periods of cloudiness, with scattered showers in Regions 8, 9, Central, and South Region 6. Elsewhere, brief showers. **Rainfall ranges from 10 to 30mm.**
