Weather Brief for Saturday, 05 October 2024 from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana

Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00hrs Saturday, 05 October 2024 were available for most of the stations. Johanna South in Region 6 recorded the highest rainfall of 76.3 mm.

<u>Severe Weather Advisory:</u> Areas with thundershowers will experience lightning strikes and strong winds. Persons are asked to take the necessary precautions to safeguard life and property.

Marine Advisory: Long-period waves can likely result in damage to sea defense. Marine users and sea-goers are asked to exercise caution during this time.


Synopsis: Surface-to-lower atmospheric troughs and confluence associated with very high moisture and mid-upper-level support produced widespread instabilities.

<u>Today's weather review</u>: Cloudy to overcast skies with rain and thundershowers were observed across Guyana.

Spring Tide Advisory: Citizens are advised that the spring tide advisory is not in effect.

Sea conditions:

- -Slight to moderate seas from the northeast with swells reaching 1.5 to 2.0 meters in open waters.
- -These waves will likely have periods of between 10 and 12 seconds.
- Light to gentle southeasterly breeze.

Extended Forecast

<u>Monday through Thursday:</u> Coastal areas of Guyana can expect partly cloudy and sunny skies in the morning becoming cloudy in the afternoon with a few showers. All the remaining areas can expect partly cloudy skies to become mainly cloudy in the afternoon with scattered showers and thundershowers. Rainfall is expected between 0 and 5 mm over coastal areas of Guyana, and elsewhere between 10 and 30 mm within 24 hours.

<u>Friday:</u> Southern regions 6 and 9 can expect fair and sunny skies. Rainfall is not expected to be significant. All the remaining regions can expect cloudy to overcast skies with intermittent rain and isolated thundershowers. Rainfall is expected between 20 and 40 mm within 24 hours.
