SEVERE WEATHER WARNINGS: In areas of thundershowers, lightning strikes and heavy winds may be observed.

Weather Brief for Saturday, 11 October 2025 from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana.

Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00 hrs Saturday, 11 October 2025 were available for most of the stations.

Hossororo in Region 1 recorded the highest rainfall of 23.4 mm.

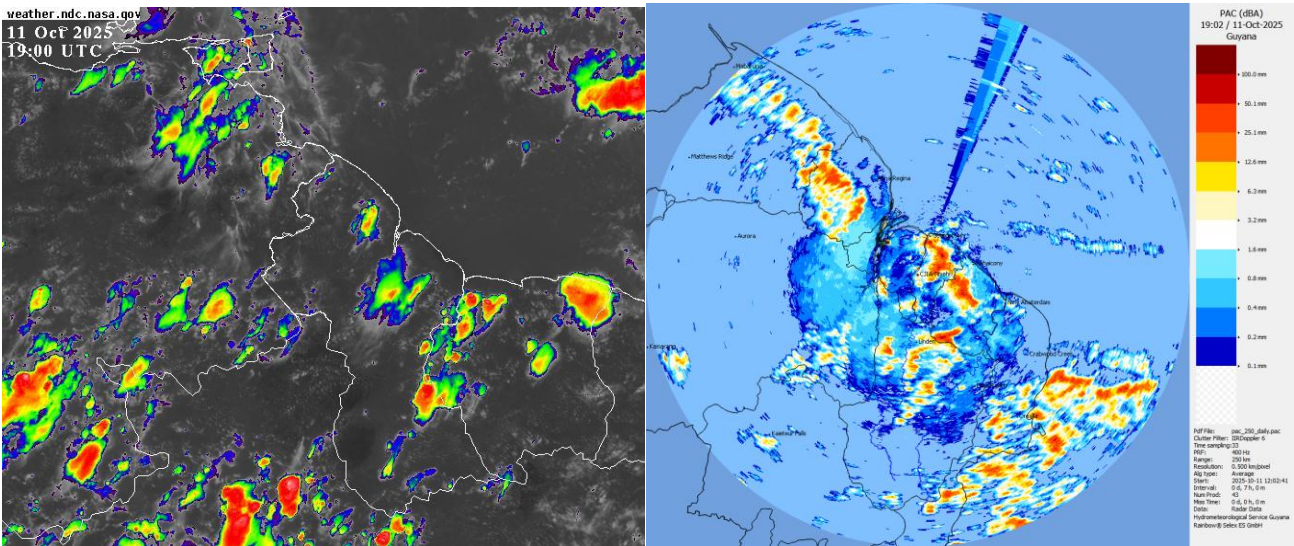
Synopsis: Low-level confluent and localised heating gave rise to unstable activities over coastal areas. This pattern will likely continue for the new week.

Today's weather review: Fair to occasionally cloudy skies with scattered showers and thundershowers.

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Sea conditions:

Moderate in open waters with northeast to easterly swells reaching 1.5 to 2.0 meters (4 to 6 ft) and steady.

- These waves will likely have periods of 5 and 8 seconds.
- Moderate easterly breeze.

Extended Forecast

Monday and Tuesday: Partly cloudy and sunny skies with isolated thundershowers in the afternoon. Rainfall is expected to be between 0 and 15 mm.

Wednesday to Friday: Mostly cloudy skies with intermittent showers with thundershowers. Rainfall is anticipated to be between 20 and 40 mm within 24 hours of accumulation. The highest values are expected in areas of thundershowers.
