Weather Brief for Friday, 24 October 2025 from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana.

Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00hrs Friday, 24 October 2025 were available for most of the stations. **No significant rainfall was recorded.**

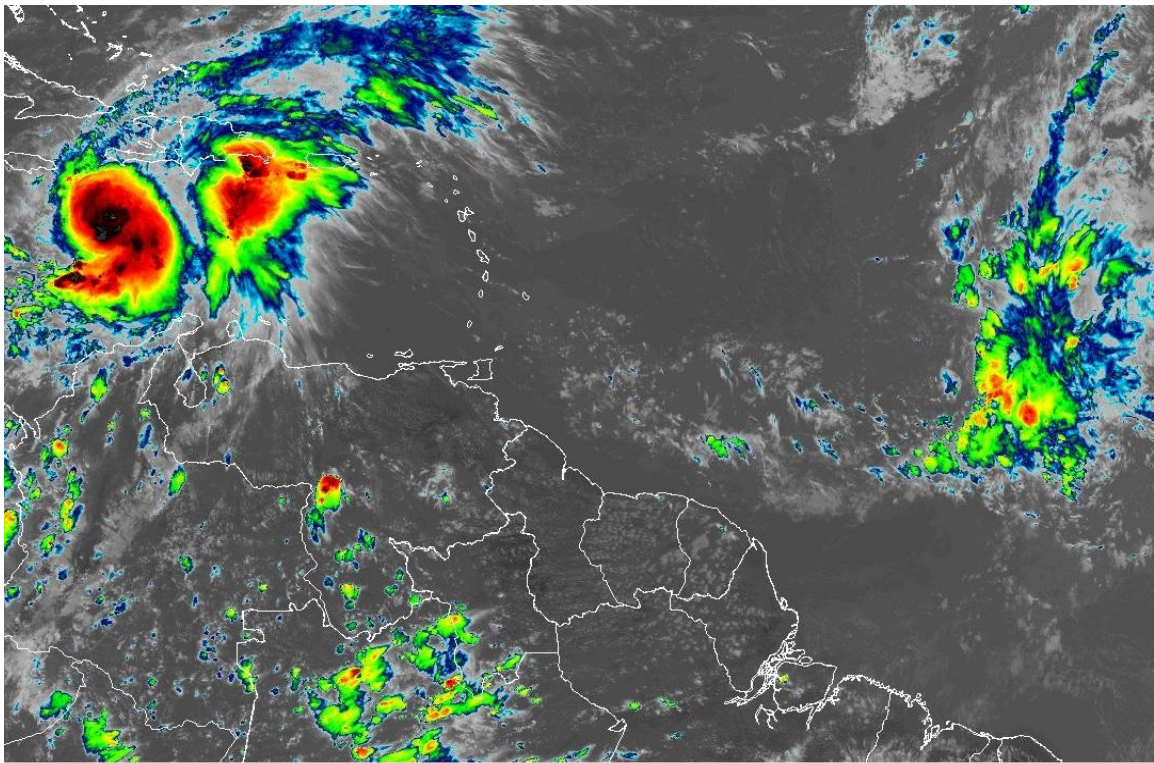
Synopsis: Ridge of high pressure remains the dominant feature over Guyana. This pattern is expected to continue over the weekend and into the new week.

Today's weather review: Mostly fair and sunny skies were observed across Guyana.

Sea conditions:

Gentle to moderate in open waters with north to northeasterly waves reaching 1.5 to 2.5 meters and steady.

- These waves will likely have periods of between 5 and 10 seconds.
- Gentle to moderate easterly breeze.

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Extended Forecast

Sunday to Tuesday: a mix of sunshine and clouds with possible isolated showers and thundershowers. **No significant rainfall is anticipated.**

Wednesday and Thursday: Cloudy skies can be expected with occasional showers and isolated thundershowers. **Rainfall is expected to be between 10 and 30 mm within 24 hours of accumulation.**
